NOTICE OF SUBMISSION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON AN
ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT
SUBMITTED BY REPSOL E&P T&T LIMITED

NOTICE is hereby given that the Repsol E&P T&T Limited (Repsol) is desirous of executing a new project involving the proposed Tie-in and Gas Supply to the National Gas Company of T&T Limited's (NGC) Gas Transmission System off the South-East Coast of Trinidad. The project entails the tie-in of a 6-inch Gas Line from the Teak Alpha Drilling Platform to the Teak NGC Compression Platform and the ultimate transmission along NGC's 24-inch gas sales pipeline and this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance ("the Certificate") pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 ("the Act").

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority ("the Authority") has, for the purposes of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and of the Authority's reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday from Monday, September 17, 2007 to Friday, October 19, 2007:

And take notice that the comments of the public are hereby invited on the Environmental Impact Assessment Report and that any person wishing to submit comments must do so in writing addressed to the Corporate Secretary, Environmental Management Authority, 8, Elizabeth Street, St. Clair, Port-of-Spain from Monday, September 17, 2007 to Friday, October 19, 2007.
