NOTICE OF SUBMISSION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON AN
ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT
SUBMITTED BY THE PETROLEUM COMPANY OF
TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO LIMITED

NOTICE is hereby given that the Petroleum Company of Trinidad and Tobago Limited (Petrotrin) is desirous of executing a new project involving the construction of a Sulphuric Acid Regeneration Unit, Acid Road Tank Wagon Loading Facility, Offsite Feed and Production Systems, Propylene/Butylenes Alkylation Unit and Continuous Catalyst Regeneration Platforming Unit and that this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 (“the Act”).

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, for the purposes of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday from Monday 1st October, 2007 to Friday 2nd November, 2007:
