NOTICE OF SUBMISSION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON AN  
ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT  
SUBMITTED BY EOG RESOURCES TRINIDAD BLOCK 4(a)  
UNLIMITED

NOTICE is hereby given that the EOG Resources Trinidad Block 4(a) Unlimited is desirous of executing a new development project involving the installation of an offshore drilling and production platform, the drilling of six (6) development wells from the production platform and the establishment of a 29km 18-inch sub-sea pipeline within Concession Block 4(a), off the East Coast of Trinidad and that this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, as amended by Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) (Amendment) Order, 2007, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 (“the Act”).

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, for the purposes of the certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday, from Monday 21st April, 2008 to Friday 23rd May, 2008:
