NOTICE OF SUBMISSION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON AN  
ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT  
SUBMITTED BY ALUTRINT LIMITED

NOTICE is hereby given that Alutrint Limited is desirous of executing a new project involving the proposed construction and operation of a 720MW Combined Cycle Power Plant at Union Industrial Estate, La Brea and that this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 (“the Act”).

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, for the purposes of the certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday, from Monday 30th June, 2008 to Thursday 31st July, 2008:
