SUBMITTED BY THE NATIONAL QUARRIES COMPANY
LIMITED

NOTICE is hereby given that the National Quarries Company Limited is desirous of executing a new project involving the conduct of Open Pit Mining of Sand and Gravel at Turure Road, Guaico, Sangre Grande. This project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, as amended by the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) (Amendment) Order, 2007 thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, (“the Act”).

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, for the purposes of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday, from Monday, 26th January, 2009 to Friday, 27th February, 2009:
