AN ORDINANCE to amend the Education Ordinance, 1933.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Education Short title. (Amendment) Ordinance, 1936, and shall be construed as Construction. one with the Education Ordinance, 1933, hereinafter No. 28 of 1933 referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Sub-section (2) of Section 16 of the Principal Ordinance Section 16 (2) of No. 28 of 1933 amended. is hereby amended by the addition of the words "controlled by the Department" after the word "curriculum" at the end of the third line.

3. Sub-section (4) of Section 23 of the Principal Ordinance Section 23 (4) of No. 28 of 1933 replaced. is hereby repealed and replaced by the following:—

(4) Subject to the provisions of sub-section (1) hereof, scholarships shall be of such amount as the Governor in Executive Council may in each case decide and shall be payable in such instalments and on such dates as the Governor may from time to time determine:
