NOTICE OF THE EXPIRATION OF THE ANTI-DUMPING DUTY
IMPOSED ON BUILDING CEMENT (GREY) ORIGINATING
IN INDONESIA

NOTICE is hereby given that an Order imposing a duty of 48% on Building Cement (Grey) listed under Customs H.S. Tariff Heading 2523.291, originating in Indonesia, came into effect on 11th October, 2002, by Legal Notice No. 40 dated 18th March, 2003.

NOTICE is also given that pursuant to section 29A(1) of the Anti-dumping and Countervailing Duties Act, 1992 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) this duty will expire on the fifth anniversary of its entry into force, that is, on 10th October, 2007, unless in accordance with section 29A(3) of the Act, the Anti-dumping Authority initiates an investigation based on *prima facie* evidence submitted by an interested person at least one month before the expiry date, that the expiry of the duty would again lead to actionable injury.
