NOTICE OF THE EXPIRATION OF THE ANTI-DUMPING DUTY  
IMPOSED ON PORTLAND GREY CEMENT ORIGINATING IN  
THAILAND

NOTICE is hereby given that an Order imposing a duty of 152.84% on Portland Grey Cement originating in Thailand came into effect on 2nd March, 2000 by Legal Notice No. 55.

Notice is also given that pursuant to section 29A(1) of the Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act, 1992 (“the Act”), this duty will expire on the fifth anniversary of the coming into effect of the Order, i.e., 1st March, 2005 unless, in accordance with section 29A(3) of the Act, the Anti-Dumping Authority initiates an investigation based on *prima facie* evidence submitted by an interested person at least one month before the expiry date, that the expiry of the duty would again lead to actionable injury.
