EXTENSION OF THE PERIOD FOR THE DIRECTION TO THE
COMPTROLLER OF CUSTOMS AND EXCISE BY THE
MINISTER OF TRADE, INDUSTRY AND CONSUMER
AFFAIRS TO SECURE PAYMENT OF A PROVISIONAL
DUTY IN RESPECT OF PORTLAND GREY CEMENT
ORIGINATING IN THAILAND

WHEREAS by Legal Notice No. 210 dated 29th October, 1999, the
Minister of Trade, Industry and Consumer Affairs directed the
Comptroller of Customs and Excise to secure payment of a provisional
duty in the amount of 199% *ad valorem* per ton with effect from 2nd
September, 1999 until 2nd January, 2000 or upon the publication of a
final determination whichever is earlier:

And whereas by section 25(4) of the Anti-dumping and
Countervailing Duties Act, 1992, a direction shall cease to have effect
following a final determination being made by the Minister under
section 26:

And whereas section 26(1A) of the Act authorises the extension of
the period of four months, between the making of the preliminary
determination and the publication of the final determination and of any
Order consequent upon that final determination, to a period of six
months, where exporters representing a significant percentage of the
trade involved request such extension or do not object to the extension
upon notification by the Anti-dumping Authority (hereinafter “the
Authority”):

And whereas the Authority has notified the exporter, Siam Cement
Trading Company Limited of its intention to extend the said period to
six months and has received no objection:

Cement originating in Thailand*

NOW, THEREFORE, the Minister of Trade, Industry and Consumer Affairs hereby extends the period between the making of the preliminary determination to the final determination from 2nd September, 1999 until 2nd January, 2000 to 2nd September, 1999 to 2nd March, 2000, during which period the direction to the Comptroller of Customs and Excise as provided in Legal Notice No. 210 dated 29th October, 1999 will remain in effect.
