THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
(CARNIVAL) ORDER, 2000

J'OUVERT

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Carnival) Order, 2000. Citation

2. Notwithstanding any enactment to the contrary, motorists attending any parade of bands at the Grand Stand may park their vehicles on the Queen's Park Savannah during the period commencing three hours before the start of the function and ending three hours after the close of the function. Parking of vehicles on Queen's Park Savannah

3. On Monday 6th March, 2000, vehicular traffic is prohibited on the undermentioned roads, and all roads within and bounded by the said undermentioned roads between the hours of 1.00 a.m. and 9.00 p.m., and parking is prohibited between the hours of 2.00 a.m. and 9.00 p.m.— Road closed Parking prohibited

- (a) Duke Street, between Belgrade Street and Wrightson Road;
- (b) Park Street, between Flament Street and Piccadilly Street;
- (c) Flament Street, between Park Street and Wrightson Road;
- (d) Independence Square North, between Wrightson Road and Piccadilly Street;
- (e) Independence Square South, between Wrightson Road and Piccadilly Street;
- (f) St. Joseph Road, between Piccadilly Street and Vieira Street.
- (g) Charlotte Street, between Oxford Street and South Quay;
- (h) Nelson Street;
- (i) Duncan Street;
- (j) Fraser Street;
- (k) Richmond Street;
- (l) St. Vincent Street, between Oxford Street and Wrightson Road;

- (m) Abercromby Street, between South Quay and Oxford Street;
- (n) Frederick Street, between Independence Square North and Oxford Street;
- (o) Henry Street, between South Quay and New Street;
- (p) Sackville Street;
- (q) Broadway;
- (r) Queen Street;
- (s) South Quay, between Vieira Street and St. Vincent Street;

- (u) Belmont Circular Road, between Charlotte Street and the Hospital Entrance;
- (v) Piccadilly Street;
- (w) Phillip Street;
- (x) Tragarete Road.

4. Parking is prohibited between the hours of 2.00 a.m. and 9.00 p.m. on Monday 6th March, 2000, on the following roads:
- (a) Oxford Street, between Observatory Street and Dundonald Street; and
  - (b) Stone Street.

One-way

5. During the times and on the dates specified in paragraph 3 vehicular traffic shall proceed along Stone Street, between Wrightson Road and Park Street, in a southerly direction.

6. (1) Parade Route of the Bands—from Grand Stand, Queen's Park Savannah, Judging Point No. 1, into Victoria Avenue, turning right into Tragarete Road to St. James Barracks into Western Main Road turning left at Mathura Street, turning left into Mucurapo Road, turning right into Taylor Street turning left into Ariapita Avenue to Adam Smith Square, Judging Point No. 2, into Park Street to Victoria Square, Judging Point No. 3, turning right into Richmond Street, turning left into Independence Square North, turning right into St. Vincent Street, turning left into South Quay in front Downtown Stand, turning left into Broadway around Cipriani Statue into Frederick Street turning right into Park Street, turning left into Charlotte Street as far as Queen's Park East, turning left into Frederick Street entrance of the Queen's Park Savannah.

(2) Belmont Bands will come from Jerningham Avenue, turning right into Queen's Park East into Frederick Street entrance to the Queen's Park Savannah and then continue to the other venues.

7. (1) On Monday 6th March, 2000, from 2.00 a.m. to 9.00 p.m. and on Tuesday 7th March, 2000, from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 p.m. parking is prohibited on the roads specified in subparagraph (2) below and all roads lying in and within the specified roads. <sup>Parking prohibited  
Road closed</sup>

(2) On Monday 6th March, 2000, and Tuesday 7th March, 2000 from 9.00 a.m. to 9.00 p.m. vehicular traffic is prohibited on the following roads, and all roads lying in and within the specified roads:

(a) Queen's Park West, from Queen's Park East to Queen's Royal College Round-a-bout;

(b) Sweet Briar Road;

(c) (i) Grey Street, between St. Clair Avenue and Tragarete Road;

(ii) Alexandra Street, between St. Clair Avenue and Tragarete Road;

(iii) Elizabeth Street, between St. Clair Avenue and Tragarete Road;

(iv) Havelock Street, between St. Clair Avenue and Tragarete Road;

(v) Broome Street, between St. Clair Avenue and Tragarete Road;

(vi) Kavanagh Street, between St. Clair Avenue and Tragarete Road;

(d) Roxy Road-a-bout;

(e) Benare Street;

(f) Cawnpore Street;

(g) Nizam Street;

(h) Clarence Street;

(i) Vidale Street;

(j) Dengue Street;

(3) On Monday 6th March, 2000, from 6.00 p.m. to 6.00 a.m. on Tuesday 7th March, 2000, vehicular traffic is prohibited on the roads mentioned from (d) to (bb) in subparagraph (2) for Monday Night Mas.

8. (1) On Monday 6th March, 2000, from 2.00 a.m. to 9.00 p.m. and Tuesday 7th March, 2000, from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 p.m. parking is prohibited on the following roads:

- (a) Circular Road;
- (b) Maraval Road, between St. Clair Round-a-bout and St. Clair Avenue, (Q.R.C. Round-a-bout);
- (c) St. Clair Avenue;
- (d) Damian Street;
- (e) De Verteuil Street;

- (f) Dennis Mahabir Street;
- (g) Wrightson Road;
- (h) Beetham Highway between Abattoir Road and Wrightson Road with the exception of taxis specified at paragraph 12(d);
- (i) Vieira Street;
- (j) Abattoir Road;
- (k) St. Joseph Road;
- (l) Foster Road;
- (m) Plaisance Road;
- (n) Picton Road;
- (o) Laventille Road;
- (p) Quarry Street;
- (q) Belgrade Street;
- (r) Codrington Street;
- (s) Parker Street;
- (t) Pall Mall Street;
- (u) Oxford Street east of Observatory Street;
- (v) Belmont Circular Road, between Observatory Street and Queen's Park East;
- (w) Belmont Circular Road, between Observatory Street and entrance to Hospital;
- (x) Jerningham Avenue, between Archer Street and Norfolk Street;
- (y) Archer Street;
- (z) Cadiz Road; and
- (aa) Lady Young Road, between the entrance to The Trinidad Hilton and St. Ann's Round-a-bout.

(2) From 4.00 a.m. to 12 midnight on Monday 6th March, 2000, and on Tuesday 7th March, 2000, between 9.00 a.m. and 12 midnight, parking is prohibited on the following roads:

- (a) that portion of South Quay and Eastern Main Road between Vieira Street, Port-of-Spain and Bushe Street, San Juan;
- (b) Abattoir Road with the exception of taxis at paragraph 12 (f) and (g).

9. During the times and on the dates specified in paragraph 8(1) vehicular traffic shall proceed as follows: One-way traffic

- (a) Coronation Street, St. James in a northerly direction only;
- (b) Luckput Street, St. James in a southerly direction only;
- (c) on Archer Street, between Belmont Circular Road and Jerningham Avenue—in a southerly direction only;
- (d) on Cadiz Road—in an easterly direction only;
- (e) Vieira Street from St. Joseph Road to Abattoir Road—in a southerly direction only.

10. Notwithstanding any enactment to the contrary, from 2.00 a.m. on Monday 6th March, 2000 to 6.00 a.m. on Wednesday, 8th March, 2000, vehicular traffic may proceed in both directions— Two-way traffic

- (a) around the Queen's Park Savannah, between Cadiz Road and Queens Royal College Round-a-bout, by way of Circular Road and Maraval Road;
- (b) on observatory Street, between Quarry Street and Belmont Circular Road;
- (c) Belmont Circular Road, between Observatory Street and entrance to Port-of-Spain General Hospital.

11. Vehicles proceeding to the Port-of-Spain General Hospital on an emergency shall travel along the following route and leave by the said route: Route for emergency vehicles to Port-of-Spain General Hospital

- (a) north along Henry Street, east into New Street onto Belmont Circular Road to the Hospital;
- (b) south from the Queen's Park Savannah, south on Dundonald Street, east along Gordon Street, south on Charlotte Street to the Hospital;
- (c) east from Belmont Circular Road and Observatory Street to the Hospital;
- (d) from Adam Smith Square and Victoria Square—north on French Street, north on Maraval Road to Circular Road and Queen's Park east to the Hospital.

12. From 2.00 a.m. on Monday 6th March, 2000 to 12 midnight on Tuesday 7th March, 2000, taxis shall operate as follows: Taxi stands in Port-of-Spain

- (a) taxis assigned to taxi stand on Chacon Street between Independence Square South and South Quay (Long

Circular/Wrightson Road) shall operate from the northern side of Dock Road, between Wrightson Road and entrance to Port Authority;

(b) taxis assigned to taxi stand on Abercromby Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay (Diego Martin/Petit Valley) shall operate from the southern side of Dock Road, between Wrightson Road and entrance to Port Authority;

(c) taxis assigned to taxi stands on the southern side of Independence Square North between Abercromby Street and St. Vincent Street, and the eastern and western sides of Cipriani Circle, between Independence Square North and Independence Square South (On-call taxis) shall operate from Ajax Street facing south;

(d) taxis assigned to taxi stands on the southern side of South Quay, between Broadway and Abercromby Street shall operate:

(i) from the northern carriageway of the Beetham Highway—west of Broadway facing east (the San Fernando Taxi Stand);

(ii) from the northern carriageway of the Beetham Highway—east of Broadway facing east (the Chaguanas Taxi Stand);

(e) taxis assigned to Morvant and Trou Macque shall operate on the northern side of the Eastern Main Road, east of the Flyover;

(f) taxis assigned to taxi stand on Henry Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay (Tunapuna/Arima/Sangre Grande), shall operate on the southern side of Abattoir Road east of Vieira Street;

(g) taxis assigned to San Juan and Round-D-Road shall operate on the northern side of Abattoir Road east of Vieira Street;

(h) Route (I) Maxi Taxi (Yellow Band) shall enter the Maxi Taxi Stand on South Quay by way of the Beetham Highway and exit by way of South Quay, on the Southern side—forty metres east of the Beetham Highway;

(i) taxis assigned to Long Circular shall operate on the western side of Long Circular Road facing north from Kathleen Street;



(j) taxis assigned to Bournes Road shall operate on the western side of Bournes Road facing north from Kathleen Street;

(k) taxis assigned to Carenage shall operate on the southern side of Western Main Road facing west from Coronation Street;

(l) taxis assigned to Port-of-Spain shall operate from—

(i) St. Clair Avenue;

(ii) Wrightson Road; and

(iii) Foreshore by Link Road.

13. (1) Vehicles proceeding east along the Western Main Road shall turn left to George Cabral Street, right to Kathleen Street across to Barbados Road, left to Jamaica Boulevard, Rapsey Street to Savannah Circular Road.

Alternate routes (can also be used as an emergency route from St. James to Port-of-Spain General Hospital)

(2) Vehicles proceeding west shall proceed via the Foreshore and Wrightson Road.

14. Bands shall enter the Queen's Park Savannah Competition Centre through the entrance on Queen's Park West, and bands from Belmont shall enter Queen's Park Savannah from Queen's Park East and shall leave through any exists on Queen's Park West, e.g., opposite Victoria Avenue, Stanmore Avenue and Cipriani Boulevard.

15. Bands shall enter the Adam Smith Square Competition Centre by way of Tragarete Road, turning south into Pole Carew Street and Ana Street, then proceeding eastwards along Ariapita Avenue and continuing.

16. Bands shall enter the Victoria Square Competition Centre by proceeding eastwards along Ariapita Avenue, turning into Park Street and shall leave by continuing eastwards along Park Street and south along Richmond Street or St. Vincent Street.

17. Bands shall enter the South Quay Competition Centre by way of St. Vincent Street into South Quay, then exit north along Broadway and proceed east along Independence Square, north onto Charlotte Street or north into Piccadilly Street Extension.

18. Vehicles shall enter Queen's Park Savannah at the following points:

- (a) Queen's Park East near St. Ann's Round-a-bout;
- (b) Queen's Park West opposite Dundonald Street;
- (c) Circular Road opposite President's House; and
- (d) Maraval Road opposite Whitehall.

19. Parking on the Queen's Park Savannah shall be in accordance with the directions of the Police Officer on duty.

20. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
