MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (SOUTH AFRICA vs. WEST INDIES) (CRICKET) ORDER, 2001

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (South Africa vs. West Indies) (Cricket) Order, 2001.

2. This Order has effect between the hours of 7.00 a.m. and Commencement and commence-ment and cossistion

- Saturday, 17th March, 2001; Sunday, 18th March, 2001;
- Monday, 19th March, 2001;

Tuesday, 20th March, 2001;

Wednesday, 21st March, 2001; and

Saturday, 12th May, 2001.

3. Parking of vehicles is prohibited on the following roads: Parking

prohibited

- (a) Tragarete Road, between Alexandra Street and Serpentine Road;
- (b) Havelock Street;
- (c) St. Clair Avenue;
- (d) Kavanagh Street;
- *(e)* White Street;
- (f) the alley-way, between Havelock Street and Broome Street;
- (g) the alley-way, between Alexandra Street and Elizabeth Street;
- (h) Rosalino Street, between Robert Street and Tragarete Road;
- (i) Pole Carew Street;
- (j) Serpentine Road, between Tragarete Road and Serpentine Place;

- (k) Elizabeth Street, between Tragarete Road and Hayes Street;
- (1) Damian Street; and
- (m) Taylor Street.

Parking restricted

- 4. Parking is prohibited as follows:
 - (a) on the western side of—
 - (i) Broome Street;
 - (ii) Alexandra Street;
 - (iii) Gray Street;
 - (iv) Serpentine Place;
 - (v) Gallus Street, between Ariapita Avenue and Warren Street;
 - (vi) Rosalino Street, between Ariapita Avenue and Warren Street;
 - (vii) Luis Street, between Tragarete Road and Robert Street;
 - (viii) Alfredo Street, between Ariapita Avenue and Tragarete Road; and
 - (ix) Carlos Street, between Ariapita Avenue and Tragarete Road;

(b) on the southern side of—

- (i) Flood Street;
- (ii) Jackson Square;
- (iii) Hayes Street;
- (iv) Sweet Briar Road, between Elizabeth Street and Alexandra Street;
- (v) Robert Street, between Damian Street and Murray Street;
- (vi) Hunter Street;
- (vii) Brabrant Street; and
- (viii) Hamilton Holder Street; and
- (c) on the northern side of—
 - (i) Jackson Square North; and
 - (ii) Seigert Square North.

5. Motorists proceeding on-One-way traffic (a) Havelock Street, between St. Clair Avenue and Tragarete Road, shall proceed in a northerly direction only; (b) Elizabeth Street, between St. Clair Avenue and Tragarete Road, shall proceed in a southerly direction only; (c) Rosalino Street, between Tragarete Road and Robert Street, shall proceed in a southerly direction only; and (d) St. Clair Avenue, between Elizabeth Street and Roxy Roundabout, shall proceed in a westerly direction only. 6. There shall be no right turn— No right turn (a) from Elizabeth Street onto Tragarete Road; (b) from Sweet Briar Road onto Elizabeth Street: (c) from Havelock Street onto St. Clair Avenue; (d) from Kavanagh Street onto St. Clair Avenue; and (e) from Broome Street onto St. Clair Avenue. 7. Motorists shall enter the King George V Car Park ("the Car Entrance to King George V Park") as follows: Car Park (a) motorists proceeding east along Western Main Road, shall turn north onto Serpentine Road and enter the Car Park through the northern entrance; (b) motorists proceeding west on St. Clair Avenue shall enter the Car Park through the south-eastern or south-western entrance; and (c) motorists proceeding north on Havelock Street, shall enter the Car Park through the south-western entrance. 8. Without prejudice to any liability incurred by the commission of a Removal and

Without prejudice to any hability incurred by the commission of a Removal and summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order $_{of vehicles}^{impounding}$ may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in $_{unlawfully}^{of vehicles}$ accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road parked Traffic Act.
