AN ORDINANCE to amend the Customs Ordinance, Cap. 194.

[5th May, 1931.]

 \mathbb{D}^{E} it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Short title. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs (Amend-Construction ment) Ordinance, 1931, and shall be read as one with the Customs Ordinance, Cap. 194, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

Method of making report of steamship by agent.

2. Sub-Section (3) of section 37 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the word "make" in the fourteenth line thereof, and substituting therefor the words "deliver, or cause to be delivered, to the Collector," and by deleting the words "and if any such agent fails to make" in the nineteenth line thereof and substituting therefor the words "such report shall be signed by the agent, No. 12.

and the necessary declaration made by him in the presence of and attested either by the Collector or a witness whose signature is known to, and who is approved by the Collector; and if any such agent fails to deliver".

3. Section 44 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby Declaration amended by inserting after the word "entry" in the dutiable goods fifteenth line thereof the words "and such declaration for home shall be made in the presence of and attested either by the Collector or a witness whose signature is known to, and who is approved by the Collector".

4. Section 48 sub-section (1) of the Principal Ordinance Declaration is hereby amended by deleting the words "the Collector sight. or other proper officer of Customs" and substituting therefor the words "the Collector or a witness whose signature is known to, and who is approved by the Collector".
