2. Subsection (2) (b) of section 17 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following :—

(b) that in converting the selling price of the said goods from foreign currency to sterling, the rate of exchange shall be the rate authorised from time to time by notice in the *Royal Gazette*.
