AN ORDINANCE to amend the Customs Ordinance, Ch. 32, No. 2

[22nd May, 1952.]

Commencement

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the Enactment advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs (Amend-Short title ment No. 2) Ordinance, 1952, and shall be read as one with the Customs Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal $_{\text{Ch. 32. No. 2}}$ Ordinance.

Section 17 of the Principal Ordinance amended

- 2. Subsection (2) (b) of section 17 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following:—
 - (b) that in converting the selling price of the said goods from foreign currency to sterling, the rate of exchange shall be the rate authorised from time to time by notice in the Royal Gazette.
