AN ACT to amend the Customs Ordinance, Ch. 32. No. 2.

[Assented to 25th March. 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment}
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) ^{Short title}
Act, 1971.

2. The Customs Ordinance is amended—

- (a) in section 2 by substituting for the definition of “private warehouse” occurring therein the following—

““private warehouse” means any building or place appointed by the Comptroller by notice in the *Gazette* to be a private warehouse;”;

- (b) in section 254—

(i) by renumbering the section 254 (1);

(ii) by adding the following subsection—

“(2) The Comptroller may by notice in the *Gazette* appoint any building or place to be a private warehouse.”.
