1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Labour Bureau Short title.
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1961, and shall be read as one with Ch. 22. No. 2.

2. The Long Title to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the words "Labour Bureau" and substituting therefor the words "Employment Exchange".

3. Section 1 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by deleting the words "Labour Bureau" and substituting therefor the words "Employment Exchange".

4. (1) Wherever the word "Bureau" occurs in the Principal Ordinance or Regulations made thereunder the word "Exchange" shall be substituted therefor.

(2) Wherever the words "Labour Bureau" occur in the Principal Ordinance or Regulations made thereunder the words "Employment Exchange" shall be substituted therefor.
