Made by the Commissioner of Police under section 68(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

THE INDEPENDENCE ANNIVERSARY STEELBAND STREET PARADE (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) ORDER, 1995

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Independence Anniversary Citation Steelband Street Parade (Temporary Provisions) Order, 1995.
- 2. This Order has effect between the hours of 4.00 p.m. on Duration Thursday, 31st August, 1995 to 1.00 a.m. on Friday, 1st September, 1995.
- 3. Subject to paragraph 5, no person may park or cause or permit Parking any vehicle to be parked on any of the following roads:
 - (a) Frederick Street, between Queen Street and Queen's Park West:
 - (b) Hart Street, between Frederick Street and Abercromby Street;
 - (c) the pitched portion of the Frederick Street entrance to the Queen's Park Savannah;
 - (d) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Abercromby Street:
 - (e) Gordon Street, between Henry Street and Frederick Street;
 - (f) New Street, between Pembroke Street and Frederick Street;
 - (g) Oxford Street, between Henry Street and Frederick Street;
 - (h) Park Street, between Pembroke Street and Frederick Street;
 - (i) Duke Street, between Henry Street and Frederick Street;
 - (j) Knox Street, between Pembroke Street and Frederick Street:
 - (k) Charlotte Street, between Oxford Street and Queen's Park East;
 - (1) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Maraval Road;
 - (m) Maraval Road, between Queen's Park West and Circular Road;

- (n) Circular Road;
- (o) Queen's Park East.

Roads closed

- 4. Vehicular traffic is prohibited on the following roads:
 - (a) Frederick Street, between Queen Street and Queen's Park West;
 - (b) Hart Street, between Frederick Street and Abercromby Street;
 - (c) the pitched portion of the Frederick Street entrance to the Queen's Park Savannah;
 - (d) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Abercromby Street;
 - (e) Gordon Street, between Henry Street and Frederick Street;
 - (f) New Street, between Pembroke Street and Frederick Street;
 - (g) Oxford Street, between Henry Street and Frederick Street;
 - (h) Park Street, between Pembroke Street and Frederick Street;
 - (i) Knox Street, between Pembroke Street and Frederick Street;
 - (j) Duke Street, between Henry Street and Frederick Street.

Parking for vehicles conveying steelband instruments 5. Drivers of vehicles conveying steelband instruments may park their vehicles on Hart Street, between Frederick Street and Abercromby Street, entering and leaving Hart Street by way of Abercromby Street.

Two-way traffic

- 6. Between 4.00 p.m. and 12.00 midnight on Thursday, 31st August, 1995, vehicular traffic may proceed as follows:
 - (a) in both directions around the Queen's Park Savannah, between St. Clair Roundabout and Queen's Park East by way of Circular Road; and
 - (b) on Charlotte Street, between Keate Street and Queen's Park East.

Taxi-stands

- 7. Taxis that ply—
 - (a) the St. Ann's route from Hart Street, shall operate from the southern side of Queen Street, between Frederick Street and Abercromby Street;
 - (b) the St. James route from Hart Street, shall operate from the northern side of Duke Street, between Pembroke Street and Abercromby Street.

8. Without prejudice to any liability incurred by the commission of Removal and a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this $_{\text{vehicles}}^{\text{impounding of}}$ Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in unlawfully accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road $_{\text{parked}}^{\text{parked}}$ Traffic Act.
