THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, CH. 32. No. 2

REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL UNDER SECTION 254 OF THE CUSTOMS
ORDINANCE

THE CUSTOMS (FEES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1967

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 1967, and shall be read as one with the Customs (Fees) Regulations, 1957, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 4 of the Principal Regulations is hereby revoked and replaced by the following:—

“4. There shall be paid to the Comptroller for duties performed by officers outside or in excess of the hours set out in these Regulations the following rates of overtime fees—

(a) on ordinary week-days and on Saturdays—

Customs and Excise Guards ... \$2.20 for each hour or part thereof;

Customs and Excise Officers ... \$4.00 for each hour or part thereof;

on Sundays and Public Holidays—

Customs and Excise Guards ... \$2.20 for each hour or part thereof for the first eight hours and \$2.75 for each hour or part thereof thereafter;

Customs and Excise Officers ... \$4.00 for each hour or part thereof for the first eight hours and \$5.40 for each hour or part thereof thereafter:

Provided that—

(i) on Sundays and Public Holidays,

(ii) on Saturdays after 1 p.m. in the case of services performed by indoor staff as specified in Regulation 3 (a) and after noon in the case of services performed by staff specified in Regulation 3 (1) (ii);

(iii) on other days between 5 p.m. and 6 a.m. overtime fees for one hour in excess of the actual time occupied in performing the services required (subject to a

minimum of two hours in all) shall be charged in respect of each officer employed so as to cover the time spent in travelling to and from the place of employment; and where arrangements have been made for summoning an officer and no demand is ultimately made for his service a fee equivalent to two hours' overtime shall be paid;

- (b) for the entering or clearing of a vessel other than a coasting vessel—\$12.00 for each entrance or clearance:

Provided that where two or more applications are made at the same time by the same person the rate shall be \$6.00 for each additional entrance or clearance;

- (c) for the entering or clearing of a coasting vessel—\$2.20 for each entrance or clearance;

- (d) for the granting of an application to load ships' stores of any kind excluding bunkers—\$12.00;

- (e) for the granting of a supplementary application extending the duration of a service or requiring the employment of additional officers—\$12.00."

3. Regulation 8 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended:—

- (a) by substituting for the symbols and figures "\$1.15" the symbols and figures "\$1.60"; and

- (b) by substituting for the symbols and figures "0.60" the symbols and figures "\$1.00".

4. Regulation 9 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended:—

- (a) by substituting for the symbols and figures "\$9.20" the symbols and figures "\$13.00";

- (b) by substituting for the symbols and figures "\$350.00" the symbols and figures "\$565.00"; and

- (c) by substituting for the symbols and figures "\$310.00" wherever they occur the symbols and figures "\$372.00".
