THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, CH. 32. No. 2

REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL UNDER SECTION 254 OF THE
CUSTOMS ORDINANCE

THE CUSTOMS (FEES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1971

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Fees) (Amendment) Citation Regulations, 1971.

2. The Customs (Fees) Regulations, 1957 are hereby amended—

(a) by revoking and replacing regulation 4 with the following—

“4. There shall be paid to the Comptroller for duties performed by officers outside or in excess of the hours set out in these Regulations the following rates of overtime fees—

(a) On ordinary Week-days and on Saturdays—

Customs and Excise Guards \$3.65 for each hour or part thereof;

Customs and Excise Officers \$5.25 for each hour or part thereof;

On Sundays and Public Holidays—

Customs and Excise Guards \$3.65 for each hour or part thereof for the first eight hours and \$4.85 for each hour or part thereafter;

Customs and Excise Officers \$5.25 for each hour or part thereof for the first eight hours and \$7.00 for each hour or part thereafter;

Provided that on Sundays and Public Holidays and on Saturdays after 1.00 p.m. in the case of services performed under paragraphs (a) and (b)(ii) of regulation 3, and after noon in the case of services performed under paragraph (b)(i) of the said regulation and on other days between 5.00 p.m. and 6.00 a.m. overtime fees for one hour in excess of the actual time occupied in performing the service required (subject to a minimum of two hours in all) shall be charged in respect of each Officer employed so as to cover the time spent in travelling to and from the place of employment:

Provided further that where arrangements have been made for summoning an Officer and no demand is ultimately made for his service a fee equivalent to two hours' overtime shall be paid;

- (b) for the entering or clearing of a vessel other than a coasting vessel—\$16.50 for each entrance or clearance:

Provided that where two or more applications are made at the same time by the same person the rate shall be \$8.25 for each additional entrance or clearance;

- (c) for the entering or clearing of a coasting vessel—\$2.62 for each entrance or clearance;
- (d) for the granting of an application to load ships' stores of any kind excluding bunkers—\$16.50;
- (e) for the granting of a supplementary application extending the duration of a service or requiring the employment of additional officers—\$16.50;
- (f) boarding of ships other than coastal vessels or aircraft—\$15.40;
- (g) issuing of a Loading Licence or Permit to discharge coastwise—\$15.40;
- (h) searching of a Content—\$15.40;

Provided that where two or more applications are made at the same time by the same person the rate shall be \$7.70 for each additional search of a Content.”;

- (b) in regulation 8—

- (i) by substituting for the symbols and figures “\$1.60” occurring therein, the symbols and figures “\$2.52”; and
- (ii) by substituting for the symbols and figures “\$1.00” occurring therein, the symbols and figures “\$1.73”;

- (c) in regulation 9—

- (i) by substituting for the symbols and figures “\$13.00” occurring therein, the symbols and figures “\$16.00”;
- (ii) by substituting for the symbols and figures “\$565.00” occurring therein, the symbols and figures “\$731.00”; and
- (iii) by substituting for the symbols and figures “\$372.00” wherever they occur therein, the symbols and figures “\$482.00”.
