ISSUED BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 3(2) OF THE BURIAL GROUNDS ACT

LICENSING OF A PRIVATE BURIAL GROUND

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on him by section 3(2) of the Burial Grounds Act, the Minister of Local Government has licensed as a private burial ground, the parcel of land described in the Schedule:

SCHEDULE

That portion of land comprising an area of 13.8 square metres at the South West corner of a larger parcel of land consisting of two (2) acres one (1) rood and eleven (11) perches more or less being a portion of seven (7) acres three (3) roods and thirty-two (32) perches described in deed registered as No. 2393 of 1937 and No. 6567 of 1951 and bounded on the North by lands of Otaheite Estate, on the South by Berridge Trace, on the East partly by lands forming a Road Reserve 50 links wide, partly by other portion of the said lands now belonging to Emmanuel Thomas, Myron St. Luis and Theodosia Hamilton and Juanita Thomas and on the West by lands of Mohess.
