REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE PRESIDENT UNDER SECTION 263 OF THE CUSTOMS ACT

THE CUSTOMS (EXTRA GUARD RECRUITMENT)
REGULATIONS, 2004

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Extra Guard Recruitment) Regulations, 2004. Citation

2. A person who seeks recruitment as an extra guard shall make an application in writing to the Comptroller accompanied by— Applications

- (a) a statement of particulars of former employment, where previously employed; and
- (b) two references or testimonials.

3. A person who—

- (a) is a citizen or resident of Trinidad and Tobago;
- (b) is over eighteen years of age;
- (c) is of sound health, as evidenced by a certificate issued by a Government Medical Officer nominated for the purpose;
- (d) is of good character, as evidenced by a valid certificate of character issued by the Commissioner of Police,

for

shall be eligible for recruitment as an extra guard.

4. A person recruited as an extra guard shall be placed on probation for a period of six months and shall be required to perform duties under the orders of or with the concurrence of the Comptroller. Probation for
extra guards
