ISSUED BY THE COMPTROLLER OF CUSTOMS AND EXCISE UNDER SECTION 255
OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE AND REGULATION 3 OF THE CUSTOMS
REGULATIONS

THE CUSTOMS FORMS (AMENDMENT) NOTICE, 1973

1. This Notice may be cited as the Customs Forms (Amendment) Notice, 1973, and shall be read as one with the forms contained in the Appendix to the Customs Regulations.

2. Forms C.19 (Re-revised), C.20 (Re-revised), C.31 (Re-revised), C.33 (Re-revised), C.34 (Re-revised), C.35 (Re-revised), C.40 (Re-revised), C.73 and C.74, contained in the Appendix to the Customs Regulations are hereby cancelled and replaced by the revised Forms contained in the nine (9) Appendices hereto.

- A. PURCHASE TAX – If any of the goods are of a kind chargeable with Purchase Tax, the appropriate Purchase Tax form must be completed and attached to this form.
- B. IMPORTER AND CONSIGNOR – The name of both the importer and the consignor must be given, a reference number may be inserted if desired. The “importer” includes any owner or other person possessed of or beneficially interested in the goods at any time between their importation and their clearance from Customs charge. If the goods are imported under a contract of sale, the “Consignor” is the person selling them; otherwise the “Consignor” is the person owning the goods immediately before their importation.
- C. DESCRIPTION – Goods must be described in such a manner as to show their precise nature and in sufficient detail to enable them to be identified for both tariff and statistical purposes.
- D. VALUE – A separate value must be given for each description of goods. The original invoice giving details of the goods of each description must be presented with this entry.
- E. SIGNATORIES – The declaration on the entry may be signed by or on behalf of the importer as follows:—
- (a) if the importer is an individual, by (i) the actual importer, or (ii) a person in his employment if duly authorised in writing by him;
 - (b) if the importer is a partnership, by (i) one of the partners or (ii) a person in their employment if duly authorised in writing by a partner;
 - (c) if the importer is a company incorporated in Trinidad and Tobago under the Companies Acts, by (i) a director or the Secretary, or (ii) any other officer of the company if duly authorised in writing by a director or the secretary;
 - (d) if the importer is a corporation incorporated in Trinidad and Tobago by Statute, by (i) a person authorised by law to sign for the corporation, or (ii) an employee of the corporation if duly authorised in writing by such a person;
 - (e) if the importer is a foreign firm or company, or a corporation incorporated abroad by statute, by a person authorised by the law of the country of the firm or company to sign for the firm or company,
- or, as an agent of the importer, by any firm or company carrying on the business of shipping or forwarding agents whom the importer has authorised to act as his agent for Customs purposes.
- The person signing the declaration must show the capacity in which he signs and, when acting as agent for the importer, may be required to produce the importer's written authority to act as his agent for Customs purposes. When the signatory is a clerk or other officer acting for the principal or authorised agent, he must give his full signature and description and the name of his employers.
- F. Any person who makes or signs or causes to be made or signed any declaration relative to Customs which is untrue in any material particular is liable to heavy penalties.
- G. Where duty is payable at a specific rate and the unit for duty differs from the unit for Statistical purposes, both units must be shown.

- A. PURCHASE TAX - If any of the goods are of a kind chargeable with Purchase Tax, the appropriate Purchase Tax form must be completed and attached to this form.
- B. IMPORTER AND CONSIGNOR - The name of both the importer and the consignor must be given, a reference number may be inserted if desired. The "importer" includes any owner or other person possessed of or beneficially interested in the goods at any time between their importation and their clearance from Customs charge. If the goods are imported under a contract of sale, the "Consignor" is the person selling them; otherwise the "Consignor" is the person owning the goods immediately before their importation.
- C. DESCRIPTION - Goods must be described in such a manner as to show their precise nature and in sufficient detail to enable them to be identified for both tariff and statistical purposes.
- D. VALUE - A separate value must be given for each description of goods. The original invoice giving details of the goods of each description must be presented.
- E. DUTY - Where an entry comprises goods of different tariff or statistical description, the total duty payable on each separate description must be given. When articles liable to *ad valorem* duty are also liable to specific duty, the specific duty should be separately shown.
- F. SIGNATORIES - The declaration on the entry may be signed by or on behalf of the importer as follows:-
- (a) if the importer is an individual, by (i) the actual importer, or (ii) a person in his employment if duly authorised in writing by him;
 - (b) if the importer is a partnership, by (i) one of the partners or (ii) a person in their employment if duly authorised in writing by a partner;
 - (c) if the importer is a company incorporated in Trinidad and Tobago under the Companies Acts, by (i) a director or the Secretary, or (ii) any other officer of the company if duly authorised in writing by a director or the secretary;
 - (d) if the importer is a corporation incorporated in Trinidad and Tobago by Statute, by (i) a person authorised by law to sign for the corporation, or (ii) an employee of the corporation if duly authorised in writing by such a person;
 - (e) if the importer is a foreign firm or company, or a corporation incorporated abroad by statute, by a person authorised by the law of the country of the firm or company to sign for the firm or company.
- or, as an agent of the importer, by any firm or company carrying on the business of shipping or forwarding agents whom the importer has authorised to act as his agent for Customs purposes.
- The person signing the declaration must show the capacity in which he signs and, when acting as agent for the importer, may be required to produce the importer's written authority to act as his agent for Customs purposes. When the signatory is a clerk or other officer acting for the principal or authorised agent, he must give his full signature and description and the name of his employers.
- G. Any person who makes or signs or causes to be made or signed any declaration relative to Customs which is untrue in any material particular is liable to heavy penalties.
- H. Where duty is payable at a specific rate and the unit for duty differs from the unit for Statistical purposes, both units must be shown.
