BOUNDARIES COMMISSION (LOCAL GOVERNMENT) ACT

THE ELECTIONS AND BOUNDARIES COMMISSION (LOCAL
GOVERNMENT) (MUNICIPAL COUNCILS) ORDER, 1987

WHEREAS under section 71 of the Constitution of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago there is established an Elections and Boundaries Commission (hereinafter referred to as “the Commission”):

And whereas under subsection (1) of section 4 of the Elections and Boundaries Commission (Local Government) Act, (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”), the Commission is charged *inter alia* with responsibility for defining and reviewing the boundaries of the electoral districts into which an electoral area is or is to be divided:

And whereas in accordance with paragraph (a) of the said subsection (1) of section 4 of the Act, the Commission, on the 21st day of December, 1985, submitted to the Minister a report in which it recommends that for the purposes of Municipal Council Elections the boundaries of the several electoral districts into which each electoral area mentioned in the first column of Part II of the First Schedule to the Act is divided, should be as defined in the Schedule to this Order:

And whereas it is provided by subsection (3) of section 4 of the Act, that as soon as may be after the Commission has submitted a report under paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of the said section 4, the Minister shall lay before the House of Representatives for its approval, the draft of an Order by the President for giving effect, whether with or without modifications to the recommendations contained in the report:

And whereas a draft of this Order giving effect to the recommendations contained in the report of the Commission was laid before the House of Representatives for its approval by the Minister on the 8th day of May, 1987, and was approved by resolution of the House of Representatives on the 8th day of May, 1987:

Now, therefore, I, NOOR MOHAMED HASSANALI, President do hereby order as follows:

- Citation** 1. This Order may be cited as the Elections and Boundaries Commission (Local Government) (Municipal Councils) Order, 1987.
- Boundaries defined in Schedule** 2. The boundaries of the electoral districts comprising the electoral areas mentioned in the first column of Part II of the First Schedule to the Act are as defined in the Schedule to this Order.
- Commencement** 3. This Order shall come into operation on the 17th day of June, 1987.

Comprising the following Polling Divisions:

0235, 0240, 0245, 0250, 0255, 0270, 0275, 0280

ELECTORATE—4,399

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land.)

NORTH—From the point on the north-western boundary of the City of Port-of-Spain (as defined in the First Schedule of the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinance, Chapter 39, No. 1) as indicated by a Monument on the north-western corner of lands of the Church of England proceeding eastwards along the northern boundary to the point on the southern boundary of Fort George Road at about 1,330 feet from the junction of Fort George Road and the Western Main Road; thence proceeding north-eastwards along the southern boundary of the said road to the northern boundary of the Public Cemetery; thence eastwards along the said boundary to and along the South bank of the Murray Ravine into and along the South bank of the Bournes Road Ravine to the point where Bombay Street crosses it.

EAST —From the last mentioned point proceeding southwards along Bombay Street to Delhi Street; thence westwards along Delhi Street to Mooneram Street; thence southwards along Mooneram Street to Ranjit Kumar Street; thence westwards along Ranjit Kumar Street to Bournes Road; thence southwards along the said road to the Western Main Road; thence westwards along the Western Main Road to Luckput Street; thence southwards along the said street to Mucurapo Road; thence proceeding southwards along an imaginary straight line across Mucurapo Road and passing between Lots Nos. 47 and 49, Mucurapo Road to a point on the sea coast.

SOUTH—From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally north-westerly direction along the sea coast to a point on the south-western corner of lands of the Church of England at the western boundary of the City of Port-of-Spain (as defined in the First Schedule of the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinance, Chapter 39, No. 1).

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land.)

NORTH—From the point at the northern boundary of the City of Port-of-Spain (as defined in the First Schedule of the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinance, Chapter 39, No. 1) where the South bank of the Bournes Road Ravine is crossed by Bombay Street proceeding in a north-easterly direction along the South bank of the said ravine to the western boundary of lands of the State (known as Imperial Lands); thence southwards along the western boundary of the said lands to the northern boundary of Patna Street; thence eastwards along the northern boundary of Patna Street to the eastern boundary of Long Circular Road; thence southwards along the eastern boundary of Long Circular Road to the point at its intersection with the Western Main Road.

EAST —From the last mentioned point proceeding westwards along the Western Main Road to Vidale Street; thence southwards along the said street to Panka Street; thence westwards along Panka Street to the West bank of Bournes Road Ravine; thence southwards along the West bank of the Bournes Road Ravine to the point at its mouth on the sea coast.

NORTH—From a point at the intersection of Vidale Street with the Western Main Road proceeding south-eastwards along the said road to its northern boundary at a point where it meets the eastern boundary of Long Circular Road; thence in a south-easterly direction along the northern boundary of the Western Main Road to Tragarete Road and continuing along Tragarete Road to a point at its intersection with Luis Street.

EAST —From the last mentioned point proceeding southwards along the said street to Roberts Street; thence westwards along Roberts Street to Rosalino Street; thence southwards along Rosalino Street to Wrightson Road; thence westwards along the said road to the access road to International Foods Limited; thence southwards along the access road to the North bank of the Trinidad and Tobago Electricity Commission's outflow; thence first westwards along the said bank and thence southwards along the West bank to a point on the sea coast.

SOUTH—From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally westerly direction along the sea coast to the point where Bournes Road Ravine empties into the sea.

WEST —From the last mentioned point proceeding northwards along the East bank of the said ravine across Mucurapo Road to the point where it is crossed by Panka Street; thence eastwards along the said street to Vidale Street; thence northwards along Vidale Street to the Western Main Road at the point of commencement.

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land.)

NORTH—From the point where the East bank of the Maraval River is crossed by the northern boundary of Rapsey Street proceeding in a generally easterly direction along the northern boundary of the said street to the western boundary of Saddle Road; thence in a generally south-easterly direction along the said western boundary of Saddle Road to the northern boundary of Circular Road; thence eastwards along the northern boundary of Circular Road to the point of intersection with Queen's Park East.

EAST —From the last mentioned point proceeding southwards along Queen's Park East to Queen's Park West; thence westwards along Queen's Park West to Frederick Street; thence southwards along Frederick Street to Park Street; thence westwards along Park Street to the point of intersection with Tragarete Road.

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land.)

NORTH—From a point at the intersection of Luis Street and Tragarete Road proceeding south-eastwards along the said road to the point at its junction with St. Vincent Street.

EAST —From the last mentioned point proceeding southwards along St. Vincent Street to its intersection with Wrightson Road and South Quay; thence proceeding southwards by an imaginary straight line to the point on the sea coast at Queen's Wharf.

SOUTH—From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally north-westerly direction along the sea coast to the point on the East bank of the Trinidad and Tobago Electricity Commission's outflow.

WEST —From the last mentioned point proceeding first northwards along the said bank and thence eastwards along the North bank of the said outflow to the point where it is crossed by the access road to International Foods Limited; thence northwards along the said road to Wrightson Road; thence eastwards along Wrightson Road to Rosalino Street; thence northwards along the said street to Roberts Street; thence eastwards along Roberts Street to Luis Street; thence northwards along Luis Street to Tragarete Road at the point of commencement.

ELECTORATE—4,328

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land.)

NORTH—From the point at the junction of Queen's Park East and Jerningham Avenue, proceeding eastwards along Jerningham Avenue to the point on the West bank of the St. Anns River.

EAST —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally south-easterly direction along the West bank of the said river to the point where Samuel Lane meets it; thence eastwards along Samuel Lane to Belmont Circular Road; thence south-westwards along Belmont Circular Road to Observatory Street; thence south-westwards along the said street to Siparia Hill; thence eastwards along Siparia Hill to Basilon Street; thence south-eastwards along Basilon Street to Belgrade Street; thence continuing south-eastwards along Belgrade Street to Duke Street; thence south-westwards along Duke Street to the point where it crosses the West bank of the St. Anns River; thence south-eastwards along the West bank of the said river to the point where it is crossed by Prince Street; thence westwards along Prince Street to Nelson Street; thence southwards along Nelson Street to South Quay; thence proceeding southwards along an imaginary straight line to the West bank of an unnamed ravine passing between Lots Nos. 21A and 23 Beetham Highway; thence continuing southwards along the said unnamed ravine passing between Lots Nos. 21A and 23 Beetham Highway to the point on the sea coast.

Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land.)

NORTH—From a point at a junction of Prince Street and Nelson Street proceeding eastwards along Prince Street to the point where it crosses the West bank of the St. Anns River; thence in a generally south-easterly direction along the said bank to the junction of Besson Street, Old St. Joseph Road and Independence Square; thence in a generally easterly direction along Besson Street to Piccadilly Street; thence in a northerly direction along Piccadilly Street to St. Paul Street; thence in an easterly direction along St. Paul Street to Clifton Lane; thence north-eastwards along Clifton Lane to Irving Lane; thence westwards along Irving Lane to Annette Street; thence in a generally northerly direction along the said street to Clifton Circular Road; thence in a generally easterly direction along the said road; to and along the northern boundary of lands of Port-of-Spain Corporation Laventille Reservoir to the north-eastern corner of the said parcel of land at a point on the eastern boundary of the City of Port-of-Spain.

EAST —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally southerly direction along the eastern boundary of the City of Port-of-Spain to a point on the sea coast.

SOUTH—From the last mentioned point proceeding westwards and thence north-eastwards along the said coast to a point on the East bank of an unnamed ravine passing between Lots Nos. 21A and 23 Beetham Highway.

Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land.)

NORTH—From the point where Duke Street crosses the East bank of the St. Anns River proceeding north-eastwards along Duke Street to Belgrade Street; thence north-westwards along Belgrade Street to Constitution Hill; thence north-eastwards

along Constitution Hill to Schuller Street; thence in a generally south-easterly direction along the said street to Fromager Street; thence north-eastwards along Fromager Street to La Resource Street; thence in a generally south-easterly direction along La Resource Street to the point where it meets an unnamed alley running in an easterly direction between Lots Nos. 14 and 16, La Resource Street; thence eastwards along the said unnamed alley to Laventille Road; thence eastwards along the said road to the point on the eastern boundary of the City of Port-of-Spain.

EAST —From the last mentioned point proceeding southwards along the eastern boundary of the City of Port-of-Spain to a point at the north-eastern corner of lands of the Port-of-Spain Corporation Laventille Reservoir.

ELECTORATE—4,324

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land.)

NORTH—From a point at the junction of Quarry Street and Belgrade Street proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction along Quarry Street to Monsegue Street; thence eastwards and thence north-eastwards along Monsegue Street to Oxford Street; thence in a generally north-easterly direction along Oxford Street to Thornhill Street; thence in a north-westerly direction along Thornhill Street to Gloster Lodge Road; thence eastwards along the said road to Lange Street; thence northwards along the said street to Vincent Brown Street; thence eastwards along Vincent Brown Street to Quarry Circular Road; thence proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction along Quarry Circular Road to the point where it crosses the eastern boundary of the City of Port-of-Spain.

EAST —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally southerly direction along the eastern boundary of the City of Port-of-Spain to a point on the northern boundary of Laventille Road.

SOUTH—From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally south-westerly direction along the northern boundary of Laventille Road to an unnamed alley running in a westerly direction between Lots Nos. 138 and 140, Laventille Road; thence westwards along the said unnamed alley to La Resource Street; thence in a generally north-westerly direction along the said street to Fromager Street; thence south-westwards along Fromager Street to Schuller Street; thence north-westwards along Schuller Street to Constitution Hill; thence south-westwards along Constitution Hill to Belgrade Street; thence north-westwards along the said street to Basilon Street; thence in a generally north-westerly direction along Basilon Street to Siparia Hill.

Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land.)

NORTH—From the point at the junction of Belmont Circular Road and Norfolk Street proceeding eastwards along Belmont Circular Road to Belle Eau Road; thence eastwards along Belle Eau Road to the eastern boundary of the City Limits; thence in a generally south-easterly direction along the eastern boundary of the City of Port-of-Spain to the point where it is crossed by Quarry Circular Road.

EAST —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally south-westerly direction along Quarry Circular Road to the point at its junction with Vincent Brown Street.

SOUTH—From the last mentioned point proceeding westwards along Vincent Brown Street to Lange Street; thence southwards along Lange Street to Gloster Lodge Road; thence westwards along the said road to Thornhill Street; thence south-eastwards along the said street to Oxford Street; thence south-westwards along Oxford Street to Monsegue Street; thence south-westwards and then westwards along Monsegue Street to Quarry Street; thence westwards along Quarry Street to Belgrade Street; thence southwards, eastwards and again southwards along Belgrade Street to Siparia Hill; thence westwards along Siparia Hill to the point at its junction with Observatory Street.

WEST —From the last mentioned point proceeding north-eastwards along the said street to Belmont Circular Road; thence north-eastwards and then northwards along Belmont Circular Road to the point at its junction with Norfolk Street at the point of commencement.

ELECTORAL DISTRICT OF BELMONT EAST

ELECTORATE—4,476

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land.)

NORTH—From the point on the northern boundary of the City of Port-of-Spain where an imaginary straight line drawn due North from the junction of Pelham Street and Belmont Circular Road meets it, proceeding eastwards along the said boundary to the north-eastern boundary of the City of Port-of-Spain.

EAST —From the last mentioned point proceeding southwards along the eastern boundary of the City of Port-of-Spain to a point on the southern boundary of Belle Eau Road.

SOUTH—From the last mentioned point proceeding westwards along Belle Eau Road to a point at its junction with Belmont Circular Road.

WEST —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a northerly direction along the latter road to Erthig Road; thence westwards along Erthig Road to Pelham Street; thence in a generally north-easterly direction along the said street to Meyler Street; thence eastwards along Meyler Street to Belmont Circular Road; thence in a generally north-easterly and thence north-westerly direction along the said road to its junction with Pelham Street; thence proceeding northwards along an imaginary straight line to a point on the northern boundary of the City of Port-of-Spain at the point of commencement.
