BOUNDARIES COMMISSION (LOCAL GOVERNMENT) ACT

THE ELECTIONS AND BOUNDARIES COMMISSION (LOCAL  
GOVERNMENT) (COUNTY COUNCILS) ORDER, 1987

WHEREAS under section 71 of the Constitution of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago there is established an Elections and Boundaries Commission (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission"):

And whereas under subsection (1) of section 4 of the Elections and Boundaries Commission (Local Government) Act, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") the Commission is charged *inter alia* with responsibility for defining and reviewing the boundaries of the electoral districts into which an electoral area is or is to be divided:

And whereas in accordance with paragraph (a) of the said subsection (1) of section 4 of the Act, the Commission, on the 21st day of December, 1985, submitted to the Minister a report in which it recommends that for the purposes of County Council Elections the boundaries of the several districts into which each electoral area mentioned in the first column of Part 1 of the First Schedule to the Act is divided, should be as defined in the Schedule to this Order:

And whereas it is provided by subsection (3) of section 4 of the Act, that as soon as may be after the Commission has submitted a report under paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of the said section 4, the Minister shall lay before the House of Representatives for its approval, the draft of an Order by the President for giving effect, whether with or without modifications to the recommendations contained in the report:

And whereas a draft of this Order giving effect to the recommendations contained in the report of the Commission was laid before the House of Representatives for its approval by the Minister on the 8th day of May, 1987, and was approved by resolution of the House of Representatives on the 8th day of May, 1987:

Now, therefore, I, NOOR MOHAMED HASSANALI, President do hereby order as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Elections and Boundaries Citation Commission (Local Government) (County Councils) Order, 1987.
2. The boundaries of the electoral districts comprising the electoral areas mentioned in Part I of the First Schedule to the Act are as defined in the Schedule to this Order. Boundaries defined in Schedule
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 17th day of June, 1987. Commencement

ELECTORATE—8,894

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land.)

**NORTH**—From Point Rouge on the sea coast proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction along the said coast to a point on the eastern boundary of the area formerly leased to the United States Government.

**EAST** —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally south-easterly direction along the eastern boundary of the area formerly leased to the United States Government to the north-western corner of lands of A. Jobity; thence southwards along the western boundary of the said lands to the northern boundary of lands of A. Smith; thence westwards and southwards along the northern and western boundaries of lands of A. Smith to the south-western corner of the last named parcel of land; thence proceeding south-eastwards along an imaginary straight line to the north-western corner of lands of C.L.V. Vespry; thence eastwards along the northern boundary of the said lands to the west bank of the Cumana River; thence south-eastwards along the said bank to the north-western corner of lands reserved for a Quarry; thence eastwards along the northern boundaries of the said lands and lands of Simon Thomas to a point on a ridge of hills, thence proceeding south-westwards along the said ridge of hills to the north-eastern corner of lands of L. Westerman; thence westwards along the northern boundary of the said lands and lands of A. Gittens (2a. Or. 25p.) to the north-western corner of the last named lands on La Horquette Road; thence in a generally south-easterly direction along the said road to a point at its junction with the Western Main Road; thence eastwards along the said road to the point where it crosses the West bank of the Diego Martin River; thence southwards along the West bank of the said river to the point on the sea coast.

**SOUTH & WEST**—From the last mentioned point proceeding westwards and then northwards along the sea coast to Point Rouge at the point of commencement.

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land.)

**NORTE**—From a point on the sea coast at the eastern boundary of the area formerly leased to the United States Government, proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction along the said coast to the point where an imaginary straight line drawn due North from the North Post Trigonometrical Station meets it.

**EAST** —From the last mentioned point proceeding southwards along the said imaginary straight line to the North Post Trigonometrical Station on the North Post Road; thence eastwards and southwards along the said road to Diego Martin Main Road; thence westwards and southwards along the said road to a point at its junction with Semper Gardens Road.

**SOUTH**—From the last mentioned point proceeding westwards along Semper Gardens Road to its western end at the southern boundary of lands of WIPCO Limited formerly Cyril Van Bruin La Croix (93a. 2r. 31p.); thence westwards and northwards along the southern and western boundaries of the said lands to the north-eastern corner of lands of Samuel Griffith; thence westwards along the northern boundary of the said lands to its north-western corner; thence proceeding westwards along an imaginary straight line to the point on a ridge of hills; thence south-westwards along the said ridge of hills to the south-eastern corner of lands of Arnold Smith; thence westwards along the southern boundaries of the said lands and lands of T. Harris and D. Charles to the east bank of the Cumana River; thence northwards along the said river into and along the northern boundary of lands of C.L.V. Vespry to its north-western corner; thence proceeding north-westwards along an imaginary straight line from the north-western corner of lands of C.L.V. Vespry to the south-western corner of lands of Andried Smith; thence northwards and eastwards along the western and northern boundaries of the said lands to the south-western corner of lands of Arthur Jobity (10 acres); thence northwards along the western boundaries of the said lands to the eastern boundary of the area formerly leased to the United States Government.

**WEST** —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally north-westerly direction along the eastern boundary of the area formerly leased to the United States Government to the sea coast at the point of commencement.

ELECTORATE—8,695

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land.)

**NORTH**—From a point at a ridge of hills where an imaginary straight line drawn due West from the north-western corner of lands of Samuel Griffith meets it; thence proceeding due East along the said imaginary straight line to the north-western corner of lands of Samuel Griffith; thence eastwards along the northern boundary of the said lands to the western boundary of lands of WIPCO Limited formerly Cyril Van Bruin La Croix (93a. 2r. 31p.); thence southwards and then eastwards along the western and southern boundaries of the said lands to the western end of Semper Gardens Road; thence eastwards along the said road to Diego Martin Main Road; thence southwards along Diego Martin Main Road to Crystal Stream; thence eastwards along Crystal Stream to the point at its junction with Morne Coco Road.

**EAST** —From the last mentioned point proceeding southwards along Morne Coco Road to Union Road; thence eastwards along Union Road to Cuthbert Branch Road; thence southwards along Cuthbert Branch Road to Cuthbert Road; thence north-eastwards along Cuthbert Road to its eastern end; thence proceeding by an imaginary straight line due East to the point where Cocorite Terrace Extension meets the north-eastern corner of a parcel of State Lands on which the New Powder Magazine is situate (56a. 2r. 21p.); thence in a generally southerly direction along Cocorite Terrace Extension to and along Cocorite Terrace to the southern boundary of the Ward of Diego Martin; thence westwards and southwards along the southern boundary of the Ward of Diego Martin to the point on the sea coast.

**SOUTH**—From the last mentioned point proceeding westwards along the sea coast to the point at the mouth of the Diego Martin River; thence northwards along the East bank of the said river to the point where it is crossed by the Western Main Road; thence westwards along the said road to a point at its junction with La Horquette Road.

**WEST** —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally north-westerly direction along La Horquette Road to the point on the north-western corner of lands of A. Gittens (2a. 0r. 25p.); thence eastwards along the northern boundary of the said lands and lands of L. Westerman to the north-eastern corner of the last named lands at a ridge of hills; thence north-eastwards along the said ridge of hills to a point where an imaginary straight line drawn due West from the north-western corner of lands of Samuel Griffith, South of the Trigonometrical Station Reformatory No. 50 meets it at the point of commencement.

ELECTORATE—10,106

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land.)

**NORTH**—From the point on Cocorite Terrace Extension at the north-eastern corner of a parcel of State lands on which the New Powder Magazine is situate (56a. 2r. 21p.) proceeding eastwards along an imaginary straight line to the north-western corner of the Extravaganza Estate now Jesse Henderson; thence eastwards along the northern boundary of the said lands to Fort George Road; thence in a generally north-westerly and then south-easterly direction along the said road to the western boundary of lands of P. Carmody; thence in a northerly, easterly and southerly direction along the western, northern and eastern boundaries of the said lands to the north-western corner of lands of the Earl of Dundonald; thence eastwards along the northern boundary of the said lands to the south-western boundary of lands of St. H. Titus; thence northwards and eastwards along the western and northern boundaries of the said lands to the north-western corner of lands of William formerly Phoebe; thence eastwards along the northern boundary of the said lands to the south-western corner of lands of Alexis Bernard; thence northwards along the western boundary of the said lands to the north-western boundary of lands of Eugene Dublano; thence in a generally north-easterly direction along the northern boundary of the said lands to the western boundary of lands of Romain Gregoire; thence northwards, eastwards and then southwards along the western, northern and eastern boundaries of the said lands to its south-eastern corner at a ridge of hills passing along the western boundary of the Champs Elysees Estate.

**EAST** —From the last mentioned point proceeding southwards along the western boundary of the Champs Elysees Estate at a ridge of hills to the point where an imaginary straight line drawn northwards from the northern end of Breaves Road meets the said ridge of hills at the western boundary of the Champs Elysees Estate; thence proceeding southwards along the said imaginary straight line to the northern end of Breaves Road and continuing southwards along the said road to the point at its junction with Long Circular Road.

**SOUTH**—From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally north-westerly direction along Long Circular Road to Belle Vue Road; thence north-westwards along Belle Vue Road to the West bank of the Belle Vue Ravine; thence in a generally southerly direction along the West bank of the said ravine to the point where it crosses the southern boundary of the Diego Martin Ward; thence westwards along the southern boundary of the Diego Martin Ward to the point where it is crossed by Cocorite Terrace.

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land.)

**NORTH**—From the point at the junction of Majuba Cross Road and St. Lucien Road proceeding eastwards along Majuba Cross Road to Morne Coco Road; thence in a generally north-easterly direction along Morne Coco Road to the point at its junction with Mazalie Road (Toussaint Trace).

**EAST** —From the last mentioned point proceeding southwards along an imaginary straight line to the north-western corner of lands of Widow Max St. Clair; thence southwards along the western boundary of the last named parcel of land to its south-western corner; thence proceeding by an imaginary straight line drawn southwards to the north-western corner of lands of Albert Eligon at a ridge of hills; thence in a southerly direction along the said ridge of hills passing along the western boundary of the Rifle Range and along the western boundary of Champs Elysees Estate to the point at the eastern corner of lands of Romain Gregoire (15a. 3r. 18p.).

Titus; thence westwards and then southwards along the said northern and western boundaries of the said lands to the northern boundary of lands of the Earl of Dundonald; thence westwards along the said boundary to the eastern boundary of lands of P. Carmody; thence in a generally westerly direction along the eastern, northern and western boundaries of the said lands to Fort George Road; thence along the said road first in a generally north-westerly and then south-westerly direction to the northern boundary of the Extravaganza Estate now Jesse Henderson; thence westwards along the said boundary to the north-western corner of the said lands; thence proceeding by an imaginary straight line due south-westwards to the eastern end of Cuthbert Road; thence westwards along the said road to Cuthbert Branch Road and Union Road; thence westwards along Union Road to the point where it meets Morne Coco Road.

**WEST** —From the last mentioned point proceeding northwards along Morne Coco Road to Crystal Stream Road; thence westwards along Crystal Stream Road to Diego Martin Main Road; thence northwards along Diego Martin Main Road to the point where it meets Sierra Leone Road; thence eastwards along the said road to St. Lucien Road; thence northwards along St. Lucien Road to the point at its junction with Majuba Cross Road at the point of commencement,

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ELECTORAL DISTRICT OF DIAMOND VALE

ELECTORATE—9,027

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land.)

**NORTH**—From the point at the junction of Diego Martin Main Road and Bagatelle Road proceeding eastwards along Diego Martin Main Road to the point at its junction with St. Lucien Road.

**EAST** —From the last mentioned point proceeding southwards along St. Lucien Road to the point where it meets Sierra Leone Road.

**SOUTH**—From the last mentioned point proceeding westwards along Sierra Leone Road to the point at its junction with Diego Martin Main Road.

**WEST** —From the last mentioned point proceeding northwards along Diego Martin Main Road to the point at its junction with Bagatelle Road at the point of commencement,

Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land.)

**NORTH**—From the point on the sea coast where an imaginary straight line drawn due North from the North Post Trigonometrical Station meets it proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction along the sea coast to the point where it meets the eastern boundary of the Ward of Diego Martin.

**EAST** —From the last mentioned point proceeding southwards and then south-westwards along the eastern boundary of the Ward of Diego Martin to the point at the south-eastern corner of lands of M. G. Hale formerly M. Eleanore.

**SOUTH**—From the last mentioned point proceeding westwards along the southern boundary of the said lands to and along the southern boundary of lands of the Roman Catholic Church to the south-western corner of the last mentioned parcel of land where it abuts Saddle Road; thence northwards along Saddle Road to Morne Coco Road; thence in a generally westerly direction along Morne Coco Road to and along Majuba Cross Road to the point at its junction with St. Lucien Road.

**WEST** —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally northerly direction along St. Lucien Road to Diego Martin Main Road; thence eastwards and northwards along the said road to the North Post Road; thence northwards and westwards along the North Post Road to the North Post Trigonometrical Station; thence proceeding along an imaginary straight line due North from the said Station to the point on the sea coast at the point of commencement.

ELECTORATE—9,665

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land.)

**NORTH**—From the point at the junction of Morne Coco Road and Mazalie Road (Toussaint Trace) proceeding in a generally south-easterly direction along Morne Coco Road to Saddle Road; thence southwards along Saddle Road to the south-western corner of lands of the Roman Catholic Church; thence eastwards along the said lands and continuing eastwards along the southern boundary of lands of M. G. Hale formerly M. Eleanore to the south-eastern corner of the last mentioned parcel of land at the eastern boundary of the Diego Martin Ward; thence north-eastwards along the said Ward boundary to the point at a ridge of hills separating the St. Anns and Santa Cruz Valleys; thence south-eastwards along the ridge of the St. Anns Hills to the point at another ridge of hills between Fondes Amandes and Ariapita Roads.

**EAST** —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally south-westerly direction along the said ridge of hills passing between Fondes Amandes and Ariapita Roads to the St. Anns River; thence continuing in a generally south-westerly direction along the West bank of the said river to the north-western corner of lands of Henry Coker; thence southwards along the western boundary of the said lands to the south-western corner at Hololo Mountain Road; thence south-westwards along Hololo Mountain Road into and along Cascade Road; thence westwards along Cascade Road to St. Anns Road; thence continuing in a generally southerly direction along St. Anns Road to the point where it meets the northern boundary of Circular Road at the northern boundary of the City of Port-of-Spain (as defined in the First Schedule of the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinance, Chapter 39, No. 1).

**SOUTH**—From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally westerly direction along the northern boundary of the City of Port-of-Spain (as defined in the First Schedule of the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinance, Chapter 39, No. 1) to the point where it is crossed by the East bank of the Belle Vue Ravine.
