ORDER

MADE BY THE PRESIDENT UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE ELECTIONS AND
BOUNDARIES COMMISSION (LOCAL GOVERNMENT) ACT

THE ELECTIONS AND BOUNDARIES COMMISSION (LOCAL
GOVERNMENT) (TOBAGO HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY) ORDER, 2000

WHEREAS under section 71 of the Constitution of the Republic of
Trinidad and Tobago there is established an Elections and Boundaries
Commission (hereinafter referred to as “the Commission”):

And whereas under subsection (1) of section 4 of the Elections and
Boundaries Commission (Local Government) Act (hereinafter referred
to as “the Act”), it is provided *inter alia* that the Commission shall
define and review the boundaries of the electoral districts into which an
electoral area is, or is to be, divided and shall submit to the Minister
reports either—

- (a) showing the constituencies into which it recommends that
an electoral area should be divided in order to give effect to
the Rules set out in the Second Schedule; or
- (b) stating that, in the opinion of the Commission, no alteration
is required to the existing number or boundaries or electoral
districts in order to give effect to the said Rules”:

And whereas in accordance with subsection (1)(a) of the said
section 4 of the Act, the Commission on the 24th day of August, 2000
submitted to the Minister a report in which it recommends that for the
purposes of elections to the Tobago House of Assembly, the boundaries
of the electoral districts into which the electoral area mentioned in
Part III of the First Schedule to the Act is divided, should be as defined
in the Schedule to this Order:

And whereas by subsection (3) of section 4 of the Act, it is provided
that as soon as may be after the Commission has submitted a report
under subsection (1)(a), the Minister shall lay before the House of
Representatives for its approval, the draft of an Order by the President
for giving effect, whether with or without modification, to the
recommendations contained in the report:

And whereas a draft of this Order giving effect to the recommendations contained in the Seventh Report of the Commission was laid before the House of Representatives for its approval by the Minister on the 22nd day of September, 2000 and was approved by resolution of the House of Representatives on the 27th day of September, 2000:

Now, therefore, I, ARTHUR N. R. ROBINSON, President, do hereby order as follows:

ELECTORAL DISTRICT OF BACOLET/MOUNT ST. GEORGE

Comprising the following Polling Divisions:

4915, 4920, 4925, 4935

ELECTORATE—2,808

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land).

NORTH—From the point where Belmont Road crosses the western boundary of Belmont Estate proceeding in a generally easterly direction along Belmont Road to its junction with Belmont Crown Trace; thence proceeding eastwards along an imaginary line to the east bank of the Hillsborough West River; thence in a generally north-easterly direction along the east bank of the Hillsborough West River to the northern boundary of lands of Claxton John; thence eastwards and southwards along the northern and eastern boundaries of the said lands to the

northern boundary of Greenhill Estate; thence eastwards along the northern boundary of the said estate to its north-eastern corner; thence proceeding eastwards along an imaginary line to the point on Mount St. George-Castara Road.

EAST —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally south-westerly direction along Mount St. George-Castara Road to its junction with Windward Road; thence southwards along an imaginary line to the point on the sea coast at Hillsborough Bay.

SOUTH—From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally south-westerly direction along the said sea coast to the mouth of the Cook's River.

WEST —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally northerly and then north-easterly direction along the east bank of the Cook's River to the point where it is crossed by Northside Connector Road; thence southwards along the Northside Connector Road to Sargeant Cain Crown Trace; thence eastwards, southwards, and again eastwards along Sargeant Cain Crown Trace to Calder Hall Road; thence southwards along Calder Hall Road to Bagatelle Crown Trace No. 1; thence eastwards along Bagatelle Crown Trace No. 1 to Bagatelle Crown Trace; thence northwards along Bagatelle Crown Trace to Calder Hall Road; thence northwards along Calder Hall Road to the Claude Noel Highway; thence south-eastwards along the Claude Noel Highway to the point where it abuts the north-eastern corner of lands of V. Wylie at the west bank of a ravine; thence northwards along the west bank of the said ravine to the west bank of the Bacolet River; thence south-eastwards along the west bank of the Bacolet River to the point where it crosses the southern boundary of Friendsfield or Belvedere Estate; thence eastwards along the southern boundary of Friendsfield or Belvedere Estate to its south-eastern corner at the western boundary of Hope Estate; thence in a generally north-easterly direction along the western boundary of Hope Estate to the south-western corner of Belmont Estate; thence northwards along the western boundary of Belmont Estate to the point where Belmont Road crosses it at the point of commencement.

ELECTORAL DISTRICT OF BELLE GARDEN/GOODWOOD

Comprising the following Polling Divisions:

4930, 5050, 5055, 5060, 5065

ELECTORATE—3,158

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land).

NORTH—From the point on the crest of the main ridge of hills at the northern end of Mount St. George-Castara Road proceeding in a generally easterly direction along the said ridge of hills to the point at the source of the Belle River.

EAST —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally southerly direction along the west bank of the Belle River to the point where it is crossed by Zion Hill Road; thence in a generally south-easterly direction along Zion Hill Road to Windward Road; thence south-eastwards along Windward Road to Belle Garden Bay Road; thence in a generally south-easterly direction along Belle Garden Bay Road to its southern end on the sea coast at Mangrove Bay.

SOUTH—From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally south-westerly direction along the said sea coast to the point where an imaginary line drawn southwards from the junction of Mount St. George-Castara Road and Windward Road meets the sea coast at Hillsborough Bay.

WEST —From the last mentioned point proceeding northwards along the said imaginary line to the junction of Mount St. George-Castara Road and Windward Road; thence in a generally north-easterly and then north-westerly direction along Mount St. George-Castara Road to the point where it crosses the crest of the main ridge of hills at the point of commencement.

ELECTORAL DISTRICT OF BETHEL/PATIENCE HILL

Comprising the following Polling Divisions:

ELECTORATE—3,297

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land).

NORTH—From the point at the junction of Grafton Road and Orange Hill Road proceeding first south-eastwards and eastwards along Orange Hill Road to the point at its junction with Patience Hill Road.

EAST —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally southerly direction along Patience Hill Road to Piccadilly Road; thence eastwards and southwards along Piccadilly Road to Signal Hill Road; thence eastwards along Signal Hill Road to Lambeau-Signal Hill Road; thence southwards along Lambeau-Signal Hill Road to Old Signal Hill Road; thence westwards and southwards along Old Signal Hill Road to Hector's Trace; thence southwards, eastwards and again southwards along Hector's Trace to the point at its southern end where it abuts the northern boundary of lands of Diamond Estate.

SOUTH—From the last mentioned point proceeding westwards and southwards along the northern and western boundaries of Diamond Estate to the point where Auchenskeoch-Buccoo Bay Road crosses it; thence westwards along Auchenskeoch-Buccoo Bay Road to and along Buccoo Road to the point at its junction with Shirvan Road.

WEST —From the last mentioned point proceeding northwards along Shirvan Road into and along Grafton Road to the point at its junction with Orange Hill Road at the point of commencement.

ELECTORAL DISTRICT OF BLACK ROCK/WHIM

Comprising the following Polling Divisions:

4870, 4895, 4950, 4951

ELECTORATE—3,110

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road,

street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land).

NORTH—From the point on the sea coast at the mouth of the Courland River at Courland Bay proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction along the south bank of the said river to an unnamed trace which runs through lands of Thomas Sandy and Franklyn's Estate; thence in a generally north-easterly direction along the said unnamed trace passing through the lands of Thomas Sandy and Franklyn's Estate to Franklyn Road; thence in a generally northerly direction along Franklyn Road to the point where it meets Arnos Vale Road; thence in a generally north-easterly direction along Arnos Vale Road to the point where it meets Providence Road.

EAST —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally south-easterly direction along Providence Road to the point where it meets the eastern boundary of lands of J. de Houllain (6a. Or. 13p.); thence southwards along the eastern boundary of the said lands to the west bank of the Courland River; thence southwards along the west bank of the Courland River to the point where it meets the Providence River; thence in a generally south-easterly direction along the west bank of the Providence River to the point where it is crossed by Providence Road; thence southwards, eastwards and again southwards along Providence Road to the point where it meets Logwood Park Crown Trace.

SOUTH—From the last mentioned point proceeding south-westwards along Logwood Park Crown Trace into and along Glen Road to Plymouth Road; thence in a generally north-westerly direction along Plymouth Road to Union Village Crown Trace; thence south-westwards along Union Village Crown Trace to Orange Hill Road; thence in a generally south-westerly direction along Orange Hill Road to its junction with Grafton Road; thence proceeding westwards along an imaginary line to the point on the sea coast at Little Courland Bay.

WEST —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction along the said sea coast to the point where it meets the south bank of the Courland River at Courland Bay at the point of commencement.

ELECTORAL DISTRICT OF BUCCOO/LAMBEAU

Comprising the following Polling Divisions:

4855, 4856, 4857, 4860, 4885

ELECTORATE—3,378

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land).

NORTH—From the point on the sea coast where an imaginary line drawn westwards from the junction of Orange Hill Road and Grafton Road meets it at Little Courland Bay proceeding eastwards along the said imaginary line to the junction of Orange Hill Road and Grafton Road; thence in a generally southerly direction along Grafton Road to and along Shirvan Road to Buccoo Road; thence eastwards along Buccoo Road to Auchenskeoch-Buccoo Bay Road; thence

eastwards along Auchenskeoch-Buccoo Bay Road to the point where it crosses the western boundary of lands of Diamond Estate; thence first northwards and then eastwards along the western and northern boundaries of Diamond Estate to the southern end of Hector's Trace; thence northwards, westwards and again northwards along Hector's Trace to its junction with the Lambeau-Signal Hill Road.

EAST —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally south-easterly direction along the Lambeau-Signal Hill Road to the Claude Noel Highway; thence eastwards along the Claude Noel Highway to the Lambeau-Milford Road; thence in a generally southerly direction along the Lambeau-Milford Road to its junction with Milford Road; thence proceeding in a generally southerly direction along an imaginary line to the point on the sea coast.

SOUTH—From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally south-westerly direction along the said sea coast to the mouth of the Thompson River; thence proceeding in a generally north-westerly direction along the east bank of the Thompson River to the point where it is crossed by Milford Road; thence westwards along Milford Road to the Claude Noel Highway; thence westwards along the Claude Noel Highway into and along Milford Road to Shirvan Road; thence northwards along Shirvan Road to a road reserve passing through the Shirvan and Golden Grove Estates; thence north-westwards and westwards along the said reserve passing through the Shirvan and Golden Grove Estates to the point on the sea coast.

WEST —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction along the said sea coast to the point where it meets an imaginary line drawn westwards from the junction of Orange Hill Road and Grafton Road at the point of commencement.

ELECTORAL DISTRICT OF CANAAN/BON ACCORD

Comprising the following Polling Divisions:

4845, 4846, 4847, 4850, 4851

ELECTORATE—3,313

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land).

NORTH—From the point on the sea coast at Golden Grove Point where an unnamed road running through Shirvan and Golden Grove Estates meets the said coast proceeding first eastwards and thence south-eastwards along the said unnamed road to Shirvan Road; thence southwards along Shirvan Road to Milford Road; thence eastwards along Milford Road into and along the Claude Noel Highway and again to Milford Road; thence eastwards along Milford Road to the point where it crosses the west bank of the Thompson River; thence south-eastwards along the west bank of the said river to the point on the sea coast at its mouth.

EAST, —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally southerly, westerly,
 SOUTH northerly and again easterly direction along the said sea coast to the point where
 &WEST it meets an unnamed estate road at Golden Grove Point at the point of
 commencement.

ELECTORAL DISTRICT OF L'ANSE FOURMI/SPEYSIDE

Comprising the following Polling Divisions:

4995, 5000, 5005, 5010, 5020, 5025

ELECTORATE—2,723

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land).

NORTH,—From the point on the sea coast at the mouth of the Dead Bay River at Dead Bay
EAST & proceeding first in a north-easterly and then in a south-westerly direction along
SOUTH the sea coast to the point at Delaford Bay where an imaginary line drawn south-eastwards from the southern end of Delaford Bay Street meets it; thence proceeding north-westwards along the said imaginary line to the southern end of Delaford Bay Street; thence north-westwards along Delaford Bay Street to Windward Road; thence in a generally south-westerly direction along Windward Road to the point where it crosses the east bank of the Louis d'Or River.

WEST —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally north-westerly direction along the east bank of the Louis d'Or River to the point where it crosses the southern boundary of the Tobago Forest Reserve (6,362a. 2r. 4p.); thence proceeding northwards along an imaginary line passing through the Tobago Forest Reserve (6,362a. 2r. 4p.) to the point on the crest of the main ridge of hills; thence in a generally south-westerly direction along the crest of the main ridge of hills to the point where an imaginary line drawn southwards from the east bank of Dead Bay River at its source meets it; thence proceeding northwards along the said imaginary line to the east bank of Dead Bay River at its source; thence in a generally north-westerly direction along the east bank of the said river to its mouth on the sea coast at Dead Bay at the point of commencement.

This electoral district also includes Little Tobago, Goat Island, St. Giles or Melville Island and all other small islands as lie in close proximity to the said electoral district.

ELECTORAL DISTRICT OF MASON HALL/PROVIDENCE/CALDER HALL

Comprising the following Polling Divisions:

4905, 4910, 4945, 4946

ELECTORATE—3,340

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land).

NORTH—From the point where Mason Hall-Les Coteaux Road crosses the south bank of the Courland River proceeding in a generally easterly direction along the south bank of the Courland River to the point where it is crossed by Northside Road.

- EAST** —From the last mentioned point proceeding southwards along Northside Road to Belmont Road; thence eastwards along Belmont Road to the point where it crosses the western boundary of Belmont Estate; thence southwards along the said boundary to the point where it meets the northern boundary of Hope Estate; thence westwards, southwards and again westwards along the northern boundary of the said estate to its north-western corner; thence southwards along the western boundary of Hope Estate to the north-eastern corner of Friendsfield or Belvedere Estate; thence south-eastwards along the eastern boundary of Friendsfield or Belvedere Estate to the point at its south-eastern corner.
- SOUTH**—From the last mentioned point proceeding westwards along the southern boundary of lands of Friendsfield or Belvedere Estate to the point where it is crossed by the east bank of the Bacolet River; thence in a generally north-westerly direction along the east bank of the Bacolet River to an unnamed ravine which runs northwards from the point where the north-eastern boundary of lands of V. Wylie (2 acres) abuts the Claude Noel Highway; thence proceeding southwards along the said unnamed ravine to the point where the north-eastern boundary of lands of V. Wylie (2 acres) abuts the Claude Noel Highway; thence north-westwards along the Claude Noel Highway to Calder Hall Road; thence southwards along Calder Hall Road to Bagatelle Crown Trace; thence southwards along Bagatelle Crown Trace to Bagatelle Crown Trace No. 1; thence westwards along Bagatelle Crown Trace No. 1 to Calder Hall Road; thence northwards along Calder Hall Road to Sargeant Cain Crown Trace; thence westwards, northwards and again westwards along Sargeant Cain Crown Trace to Northside Connector Road; thence northwards along Northside Connector Road to the point where it crosses the west bank of the Cook's River; thence in a generally south-westerly direction along the west bank of the Cook's River to the point where it is crossed by Northside Road.
- WEST** —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally northerly direction along Northside Road to Providence Road; thence northwards, westwards and again northwards along Providence Road to the point where it crosses the east bank of the Providence River; thence in a generally north-westerly direction along the east bank of the Providence River to its confluence with the Courland River; thence in a generally northerly direction along the east bank of the Courland River to the point where it is crossed by Mason Hall-Les Coteaux Road at the point of commencement.

ELECTORAL DISTRICT OF MORIAH/PARLATUVIER

Comprising the following Polling Divisions:

4940, 4975, 4976, 4980, 4985, 4990

ELECTORATE—2,882

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land).

- NORTH**—From the point on the sea coast where King Peter's Bay Road meets the said coast at King Peter's Bay proceeding in a north-easterly direction along the said coast to the point on the west bank of Dead Bay River at Dead Bay.

- EAST —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a south-easterly direction along the west bank of Dead Bay River to its source; thence proceeding southwards along an imaginary line passing through the Tobago Forest Reserve (6,362a. 2r. 4p.) to the point on the crest of the main ridge of hills.
- SOUTH—From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally south-westerly direction along the crest of the main ridge of hills to the point at the northern end of Mount St. George-Castara Road; thence in a generally south-easterly direction along Mount St. George-Castara Road to the point where an imaginary line drawn due east from the north-eastern corner of Green Hill Estate meets it; thence proceeding westwards along the said imaginary line to the north-eastern corner of the said estate; thence westwards along the northern boundary of the said estate to the eastern boundary of the lands of Claxton John; thence first northwards and then westwards along the eastern and northern boundaries of the lands of Claxton John to the point where it meets the east bank of the Hillsborough West River; thence southwards along the said bank to the point where an imaginary line drawn due east from the junction of Belmont Crown Trace and Belmont Road meets it; thence proceeding westwards along the said imaginary line to the point at the junction of Belmont Crown Trace and Belmont Road; thence in a generally westerly direction along Belmont Road to the point at its junction with Northside Road.
- WEST —From the last mentioned point proceeding northwards along Northside Road to the point where it crosses the north bank of the Courland River; thence in a generally westerly direction along the north bank of the Courland River to the point where an imaginary line drawn due south from the 4 m.m. on Arnos Vale Road where the said road runs parallel to the Courland River meets it; thence proceeding northwards along the said imaginary line to the point on the 4 m.m. on Arnos Vale Road; thence in a generally north-easterly direction along Arnos Vale Road to the point at its junction with Culloden Road; thence proceeding due north by an imaginary line to the point where King Peter's Bay Road meets King Peter's Bay on the sea coast at the point of commencement.

ELECTORAL DISTRICT OF PLYMOUTH/GOLDEN LANE

Comprising the following Polling Divisions:

4955, 4960, 4965, 4970

ELECTORATE—3,086

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land).

- NORTH—From the point on the sea coast at the mouth of the Courland River at Courland & WEST Bay proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction along the said sea coast to the point where King Peter's Bay Road meets it at King Peter's Bay.
- EAST —From the last mentioned point proceeding southwards along an imaginary line to the point at the junction of Arnos Vale Road and Culloden Road; thence proceeding in a south-westerly direction along Arnos Vale Road to the 4 m.m. where the said road runs due parallel to the Courland River; thence proceeding due south by an imaginary line to the west bank of the Courland River; thence in a

generally south-westerly direction along the west bank of the Courland River to the point where it crosses the eastern boundary of lands of J. de Houllain (6a. 0r. 13p.).

SOUTH—From the last mentioned point proceeding northwards along the eastern boundary of the said lands to the point where it meets Providence Road; thence in a generally north-westerly direction along Providence Road to Arnos Vale Road; thence in a generally south-westerly direction along Arnos Vale Road Franklyn Road; thence in a generally southerly direction along Franklyn Road to an unnamed trace which runs through lands of Thomas Sandy and Franklyn's Estate; thence in a generally south-westerly direction along the said unnamed trace passing through lands of Thomas Sandy and Franklyn's Estate to the north bank of the Courland River; thence in a generally westerly direction along the north bank of the Courland River to the point at its mouth at the sea coast at the point of commencement.

ELECTORAL DISTRICT OF ROXBOROUGH/DELAFORD

Comprising the following Polling Divisions:

5030, 5035, 5040, 5045

ELECTORATE—2,777

(In the following boundary descriptions, wherever a boundary line is described as passing along a road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway, the centre line of such road, street, avenue, trace or other roadway is indicated. Wherever ownership of land is indicated by name, it should be interpreted as referring to the current or previous ownership of such land).

NORTH—From the point on the crest of the main ridge of hills, at the source of the Belle River proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction along the said crest of the main ridge of hills to the point where an imaginary line drawn northwards from the point where the west bank of the Louis d'Or River crosses the southern boundary of the Tobago Forest Reserve (6,362a. 2r. 4p.) meets the said point.

EAST —From the last mentioned point on the crest of the main ridge of hills proceeding southwards along the said imaginary line to the point where the west bank of the Louis d'Or River crosses the southern boundary of the Tobago Forest Reserve (6,362a. 2r. 4p.); thence in a generally south-easterly direction along the west bank of the Louis d'Or River to the point where it is crossed by Windward Road; thence in a generally north-easterly direction along Windward Road to Delaford Bay Street; thence in a south-westerly direction along Delaford Bay Street to its southern end; thence proceeding south-eastwards along an imaginary line to the point on the sea coast at Delaford Bay.

SOUTH—From the last mentioned point proceeding first in a southerly and then in a south-westerly direction along the sea coast to the point at the southern end of Belle Garden Bay Road.

WEST —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally north-westerly direction along Belle Garden Bay Road to Windward Road; thence north-westwards along Windward Road to Zion Hill Road; thence in a generally north-westerly direction along Zion Hill Road to the point where it crosses the east bank of the Belle River; thence proceeding in a generally northerly direction along the east bank of the Belle River to its source on the crest of the main ridge of hills at the point of commencement.

NORTH—From the junction of Union Village Crown Trace and Orange Hill Road proceeding north-eastwards along Union Village Crown Trace to Plymouth Road; thence south-eastwards along Plymouth Road to Glen Road; thence north-eastwards along Glen Road to Logwood Park Crown Trace; thence north-eastwards along Logwood Park Crown Trace to Providence Road; thence south-eastwards along Providence Road to its junction with Northside Road.

EAST —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally southerly direction along Northside Road to the point where it crosses the west bank of the Cook's River; thence in a generally southerly direction along the west bank of the Cook's River to the point at its mouth on the sea coast.

SOUTH—From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally north-westerly and then south-westerly direction along the said sea coast to the point where an imaginary line drawn southwards from the junction of Lambeau-Milford Road and Milford Road meets it.

WEST —From the last mentioned point proceeding in a generally northerly direction along the said imaginary line to the junction of Lambeau-Milford Road and Milford Road; thence in a generally northerly direction along the Lambeau-Milford Road to the Claude Noel Highway; thence westwards along the Claude Noel Highway to the Lambeau-Signal Hill Road; thence in a generally northerly direction along the Lambeau-Signal Hill Road to Signal Hill Road; thence in a westerly direction along Signal Hill Road to Piccadilly Road; thence northwards and westwards along Piccadilly Road to Patience Hill Road; thence in a generally northerly direction along Patience Hill Road to Orange Hill Road; thence in a generally easterly direction along Orange Hill Road to its junction with Union Village Crown Trace at the point of commencement.
