A PROCLAMATION

To: ULRIC CROSS, ESQUIRE

WHEREAS by section 2 of the Commissions of Enquiry Act, Chap. 19:01 it is provided, *inter alia*, that it shall be lawful for the President whenever he shall deem it advisable to issue a Commission appointing one or more Commissioners and authorising such Commissioners to enquire into any matter in which an enquiry would, in the opinion of the President, be for the public welfare:

And whereas I have deemed it advisable that it would be in the public welfare that there should be:—

- (i) an inquiry into the cause of and circumstances surrounding the alleged involvement of members of the Defence Force, the Police Service and members of the public in an incident at and in the vicinity of the "College Restaurant and Bar", Western Main Road, St. James, on Monday the 8th day of February, 1982;
- (ii) an inquiry into the identity of the persons participating and the extent of their participation in the said incident;
- (iii) appropriate recommendations relating to the matters aforesaid:

Now, therefore, I, ELLIS EMMANUEL INNOCENT CLARKE, President as aforesaid, do hereby in pursuance of the power vested in me in this behalf by the said Act and of all other powers thereby enabling issue this my Commission appointing and authorising you ULRIC CROSS, Commissioner, to hold an enquiry into the matters aforesaid and to make appropriate recommendations:

And I direct that the said Commissioner forthwith proceed at such places and times as may be convenient with due diligence and despatch to enquire into the matters aforesaid and to report to me in writing upon the said matters, and to give your opinion and recommendations and to furnish me separately with a full statement of the proceedings of the Commission and the reasons leading to the conclusions at which you may have arrived:

And I do hereby appoint LIONEL JONES, ESQUIRE to be the Secretary of the said Commission:

And this my Commission shall continue subject to any alteration or revocation thereof until you have finally reported.
