A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 38 of the Customs Ordinance, Ch. 32. No. 2, *inter alia* that the President may by Proclamation prohibit the importation, carriage coastwise or exportation until the revocation thereof of any goods whatsoever, and that such Proclamation may prohibit importation from or exportation to any particular place named in the Proclamation:

And whereas on the 18th day of April, 1967 a Proclamation (No. 5 of 1967) was duly issued prohibiting the importation from or the exportation to Southern Rhodesia of any goods whatsoever:

Now, therefore, I, ELLIS EMMANUEL INNOCENT CLARKE, President and Commander-in-Chief of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago in exercise of the powers vested in me do hereby revoke the said Proclamation.
