ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment  
follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance Short title  
(Supplementation and Variation of Appropriation)  
(Financial Year 2026) Act, 2026.

Further issue of \$2,927,371,851 from the Consolidated Fund

**2.** A further issue from the Consolidated Fund in the sum of two thousand, nine hundred and twenty-seven million, three hundred and seventy-one thousand, eight hundred and fifty-one dollars is authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the financial year ending September 30, 2026 and appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in Part I of the Schedule to this Act.

Increase in Heads of Expenditure Act No. 9 of 2025

**3.** The sums appropriated by the Appropriation (Financial Year 2026) Act, 2025, to the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule are increased by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part.

Reduction in Head of Expenditure

**4.** The sum appropriated by the Appropriation (Financial Year 2026) Act, 2025, to the Head of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule is reduced by the amount specified in the Second Column of that Part.

Sums appropriated in respect of Head specified in Part II of the Schedule may be utilised

**5.** The sum appropriated by the Appropriation (Financial Year 2026) Act, 2025, in respect of the Head of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule and not utilised at the commencement of this Act may be utilised, notwithstanding anything contained in the Exchequer and Audit Act, for the discharge of any liability incurred by reason of the increase in the expenditure in respect of the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule.


