AN ORDINANCE to amend the Friendly Societies  
Ordinance, Cap. 286.

[1st September, 1931.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Friendly Societies (Amendment) Ordinance, 1931.

Repeal of

2. Sub-section (2) of section 89 of the Friendly Societies Ordinance, Cap. 286, is hereby repealed.

Commence-  
ment.

3. This Ordinance shall operate retrospectively and shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of September, 1931.
