AN ORDINANCE to amend the Friendly Societies  
Ordinance, Cap. 286.

**B** it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Friendly Societies  
(Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1935.

Amendment  
of s. 32 of  
Cap. 286.

2. Section 32 of the Friendly Societies Ordinance shall  
be numbered 32 (1) and the following sub-section shall be  
added thereto:—

(2) Any affidavit or statutory declaration  
required or authorized by this Ordinance or by the  
rules of a registered society or branch shall not be  
chargeable with the fee of two shillings required to  
be paid by the affixing of stamps thereto.

Passed in Council this fifteenth day of November,  
in the year of Our Lord One Thousand nine hundred and  
thirty-five.
