AN ACT to amend the Industrial Relations Act, 1972

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Industrial Relations Short title:
(Amendment) Act, 1977.

2. Section 2 of the Industrial Relations Act, 1972, is amended—

(a) by inserting in subsection (1) in the appropriate alphabetical order the following—

““Municipal Council” means a Council as defined in the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinance, the San Fernando Corporation Ordinance or the Arima Corporation Ordinance;”;

(b) by inserting immediately after subsection (4) the following subsections—

“(5) For the purposes of this Act, the Chief Personnel Officer, referred to in section 13 of the Civil Service Act, 1965 shall be deemed to be the employer of any worker employed by the Municipal Councils.

(6) In subsection (5) “worker” does not include an officer as defined in section 2 of the Statutory Authorities Act, 1966.”;
