REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

**Act No. 4 of 1983**

AN ACT to amend the Friendly Societies Act, Chap. 32:50

*[Assented to 8th April, 1983]*

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as **Enactment**  
follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Friendly Societies **Short title**  
(Amendment) Act, 1983.

Section 29 amended    **2.** Section 29 of the Friendly Societies Act is amended by deleting the words “may” and “oftener” occurring in line two and replacing them with the words “shall” and “less” respectively.

Section 36 amended    **3.** Section 36 of the Friendly Societies Act is amended by repealing the words “fifty cents” occurring in line two and replacing them with the words “the cost of printing”.

Section 113 amended    **4.** Section 113 of the Friendly Societies Act is amended by including at the end of subsection (3) the words “and unless a further sum of not less than 5 per cent of the excess of revenue over expenditure is allocated to the general savings account of the society.”

First Schedule amended    **5.** The First Schedule of the Friendly Societies Act is amended,

- (a) in subparagraph 4(d) by replacing the words “a sum not exceeding one dollar for each such attendance, but not exceeding three dollars in any one month.” occurring at the end thereof and replacing them with the words “such sum as the Committee of Management may fix.”;
- (b) in paragraph 10 by deleting the words “and not to exceed sixty cents” occurring at the end of the paragraph; and
- (c) in paragraph 13 by deleting the words “once in every five years” occurring in the first line.
