AN ORDINANCE to amend the Forests Ordinance,
Cap. 141.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Forests Short title.
(Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1933, and shall be Construction.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended Amendment of

“ Prohibited Area ” means a specified area, being
part of a Forest Reserve or Crown Lands,
declared by the Governor in Executive Council
by Proclamation to be a prohibited area.

3. Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition of the following paragraph :—
“(6) enter a prohibited area.”
