AN ORDINANCE to amend the Patents Ordinance 1905, (No. 13—1905.)

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Patents (Amend-short title, ment) Ordinance 1905.

The Patents Designs and Trade Marks Ordinance (No. 76) and the Patents Ordinance 1905 (13—1905) and this Ordinance may together be cited as the Patents Designs and Trade Marks Ordinances 1905.

- 2. Sub-section (2) of Section 2 of Ordinance No. 13—Repeal. 1905 is hereby repealed and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—
  - (2.) Such application shall be made in the case of Time for a patent within twelve months and in the case making application. of a design or trade mark within four months

from such person applying for protection in the United Kingdom or the foreign State with which the arrangement is in force.
