AN ORDINANCE to amend the Pensions Ordinance,
Ch. 9. No. 6.

Commencement

[4th May, 1955.]

Enactment

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Pensions Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance,

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—
- Section 2 of

- (a) in the definition of "pensionable emoluments", by substituting for the words "in the Colony" the words "under the Government of the Colony"; and
- (b) in the definition of "pensionable office", by substituting for the words "in the Colony", appearing in paragraph (a) thereof, the words "under the Government of the Colony".

3. The amendment specified in the second column of the Schedule to this Ordinance shall be made in each of the provisions of the Principal Ordinance specified in the first column of the said Schedule.

Sections 7(1) (a), 8(1), 9(1), 14(2), 27, Second Schedule, regulations 12(1), 13, 14(1), 14(2), 16, 17, 18, 21, Fifth Schedule, paragraph 1.	For the words "in the Colony" wherever they occur there shall be substituted the words "under the Government of the Colony".
