AN ORDINANCE to amend further the Pensions Ordinance,
 Ch. 9. No. 6.

Enactment.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago, with
 the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment
 No. 3) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be read as one with the
 Pensions Ordinance, as amended, hereinafter referred to as the
 Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting for the definition of "Scheduled Government" occurring therein the following :—

"Scheduled Government" means the Government of any place or any Authority which is for the time being included in the First Schedule to this Ordinance, and includes the Government of Ceylon, in respect of any officer appointed to the service of that Government prior to the 4th February, 1948, and the Government of Palestine, in respect of any officer appointed to the service of that Government prior to the 15th May, 1948;".

3. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting, for all the words from and including the word "Government" occurring in the third line to and including the words "added thereto" occurring in the fourth line, the following words, namely, "Government or Authority or removing therefrom any Government or Authority for the time being included therein".

4. Subsection (1) of section 15 of the Principal Ordinance, as enacted by the Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952-1953, is hereby amended by substituting for the word "ten" occurring therein the words "twelve and one-half".

5. Subsection (1) of section 17 of the Principal Ordinance, as enacted by the Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, is hereby amended by substituting, for the words "commuted pensionable gratuity" occurring in the seventh line of paragraph (a) and in the second line of paragraph (b) thereof, the words "commuted pension gratuity".

6. The First Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately below the word "Uganda" the words "West African Cocoa Research Institute".

7. Any order made or notice issued by the Governor in Council under the provisions of section 2 or 3 of the Principal Ordinance purporting to declare any Authority which was not a Government to be a Scheduled Government, or purporting to add to or remove from the First Schedule to the Principal Ordinance any Authority which was not a Government, and which would have been validly and properly made or issued if the same had been made or issued under section 3 of the

of acts.

Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance, shall be deemed to be and to have been validly and properly made or issued thereunder.
