AN ORDINANCE to amend the Pensions Ordinance,
Ch. 9. No. 6.

[12th July, 1956]

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Pensions Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Short title.

2. Subsection (2) of section 7 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the words "one-half of" occurring in line 3 of the first proviso thereto.

3. Subsection (1) of section 8 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting for the words, figure and comma "Notwithstanding anything contained in section 7, where a period" occurring in lines 1 and 2 thereof the words "Where a period".

4. Section 26 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Regulation 14

5. Paragraph (3) of Regulation 14 of the Regulations contained in the Second Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

- (a) by substituting a full stop for the colon at the end of the first proviso thereto, and,
- (b) by deleting the second proviso thereto.

Application
and Savings.

6. (1) The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply only to officers who are in the public service at the date of the coming into operation of this Ordinance or who enter the public service after such date.

(2) Nothing in this Ordinance contained shall affect the rate of pension being paid or payable to, or the pension privileges, gratuities or allowances of, persons who had already left the public service at the date of the coming into operation of this Ordinance.
