AN ORDINANCE to amend the Pensions Ordinance,  
Ch. 9. No. 6.

[12th October, 1961]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the Enactment.  
advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment) Ch. 9. No. 6.  
Ordinance, 1961, and shall be read as one with the Pensions  
Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting after section 2 thereof the following section—

Declaration of pensionable offices with retroactive effect and validation thereof.

“2A. (1) The Governor in Council in any notification made by him under section 2 of this Ordinance that an office is declared to be a pensionable office may direct in the notification that the office is pensionable with effect from such past or future date as may be specified therein.

(2) Where the Governor in Council in any notification made by him under section 2 of this Ordinance before the commencement of this section, has declared an office to be a pensionable office, such office is pensionable with effect from the date specified in such notification.”
