AN ACT to amend the Pensions Ordinance,  
Ch. 9. No. 6.

*[Assented to 20th January, 1969]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, <sup>Enactment</sup>  
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and  
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and  
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Pensions Ordinance <sup>Short title</sup>  
(Amendment) (No. 2) Act, 1968.

2. Section 2 of the Pensions Ordinance is amended by—

(a) inserting in the definition of “pensionable emoluments” in respect of service under the Government of Trinidad and Tobago” the words “inducement allowance” immediately after the words “personal allowance” occurring in line two thereof;

(b) inserting immediately after the definition of “personal allowance” the following—

““inducement allowance” means the inducement allowance referred to in paragraph (a) of clause 3 of the Overseas Service (Trinidad and Tobago) Agreement, 1961.”.
