TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO  
**Act No. 32 of 1974**

AN ACT to amend the Pensions Ordinance, Ch. 9. No. 6.

*[Assented to 29th October, 1974]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, **Enactment**  
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and  
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and  
by the authority of the same, as follows :—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment) **Short title**  
Act, 1974.

2. The Pensions Ordinance is amended—

- (a) by inserting at the beginning of section 12(1) the words "Subject to section 12A and"; and
- (b) by inserting immediately after section 12, the following—

"Officer

pension,  
etc. on  
appoint-  
ment to  
approved  
post

12A. (1) An officer holding a pensionable office in the public service who, by reason only of his being appointed to an approved post, leaves that service in circumstances other than as are provided for in section 12(1) may be granted a pension, gratuity or other allowance by the Governor-General in respect of his public service.

(2) In this section "approved post" means a post not in the public service, approved for the purposes of subsection (1), by the Governor-General by Order published in the *Gazette*."

- (c) in section 13 by inserting between the words "officer" and "shall" occurring in line one, the words, "other than a pension granted under section 12A".

Commencement

3. This Act is deemed to have come into force on 1st April, 1965.
