AN ORDINANCE to extend the Pensions Ordinance to all monthly paid persons employed in the Public Service of Trinidad and Tobago. Ch. 9, No. 6.

[19th October, 1961]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof. Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pensions Extension Ordinance, 1961. Short title.

Interpretation.

**2.** (1) In this Ordinance—

- (a) "Provident Fund" means the Provident Fund maintained under the Provident Fund Ordinance;
- (b) "Schedule" means the Schedule to this Ordinance as varied from time to time under section 8.

(2) A reference in this Ordinance to a section shall, unless the context otherwise requires, be construed as a reference to a section of this Ordinance; and a reference to a subsection or paragraph shall, unless the context otherwise requires, be construed as a reference to a subsection or paragraph of the section or subsection in which the reference occurs.

**3.** (1) Notwithstanding any law in force at the commencement of this Ordinance but subject to this Ordinance, the offices set out in the Schedule shall, subject to subsection (2), be deemed to be and to have been pensionable offices within the meaning of the Pensions Ordinance—

- (a) on and after the 1st day of January, 1959, in the case of an office in existence on the 1st day of January, 1959, and
- (b) in the case of an office established after the 1st day of January, 1959, and before the commencement of this Ordinance, on and after the date of the establishment of that office,

and the Pensions Ordinance applies to those offices with effect as of that date.

(2) Subsection (1) applies only to such of those offices described therein as are monthly paid offices in the public service.

**4.** (1) Where a person had been a depositor to the Provident Fund while holding an office that is made a pensionable office by virtue of section 3, if he held that office on the 1st day of January, 1959, or at any time since that day and before the commencement of this Ordinance, and on the commencement of this Ordinance is holding that office, he may elect to continue to be a depositor to the Provident Fund and section 3 shall not be applied in respect of his tenure of that office.

(2) An election under subsection (1) shall be by written notice addressed to the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Finance.

5. Where a person employed in the public service at the commencement of this Ordinance had been a depositor to the Provident Fund while holding an office that is made a pensionable office by virtue of section 3, if he held that office on the 1st day of January, 1959, or at any time since that day and before the commencement of this Ordinance, and on the commencement of this Ordinance is holding that office and does not elect in accordance with section 4 to continue to be a depositor to the Provident Fund—

- (a) he shall forthwith surrender his bonuses from that fund and the interest thereon and all his rights to a gratuity under section 21 of the Provident Fund Ordinance,
- (b) he is entitled to count all his service while such a depositor towards pension in accordance with the Pensions Ordinance, and
- (c) he is entitled to be repaid his compulsory deposits to the Provident Fund together with the interest thereon to the date of repayment.

6. (1) In this section the expression "the amount of the gratuity granted to him under the Provident Fund" does not include the compulsory deposits made by a person under the Provident Fund and the interest thereon.

(2) Where a person who retired from the public service before the commencement of this Ordinance had been a depositor to the Provident Fund while holding an office that is made a pensionable office by virtue of section 3, if he held that office on the 1st day of January, 1959, or at any time since that day and before his retirement from the public service, he is eligible—

- (a) where the amount of the gratuity granted to him from the Provident Fund is less than the gratuity he would have received on the date of his retirement if he had been retired under the Pensions Ordinance and had elected to take a gratuity and reduced pension thereunder, for a further payment to him of—
  - (i) a sum representing the difference between the amount of the gratuity granted to him from the Provident Fund and the amount of the gratuity that he would have received had he on the date of his retirement been retired under the Pensions Ordinance, and

- (ii) a pension computed as though on the date of his retirement he had been retired under the Pensions Ordinance and had received the amount of the gratuity granted to him from the Provident Fund together with the further amount under subparagraph (i), if any, as the gratuity receivable by him upon an election under the Pensions Ordinance for a gratuity and reduced pension; or
- (b) where the amount of the gratuity granted to him from the Provident Fund is equal to the amount of the gratuity he would have received on the date of his retirement if he had been retired under the Pensions Ordinance and had elected to take a gratuity and reduced pension thereunder, for the payment of a pension computed as though on the date of his retirement he had been retired under the Pensions Ordinance and had received the amount of the gratuity granted to him from the Provident Fund as the gratuity receivable by him upon an election under the Pensions Ordinance for a gratuity and reduced pension; or
- (c) where the amount of the gratuity granted to him from the Provident Fund exceeds the gratuity he would have received on the date of his retirement if he had been retired under the Pensions Ordinance and had elected to take a gratuity and reduced pension thereunder—
  - (i) if within one month of the coming into operation of this Ordinance he pays to the Accountant General the amount representing the difference between the amount of the gratuity granted to him from the Provident Fund and the amount of the gratuity that he would have received had he on the date of his retirement been retired under the Pensions Ordinance, for the payment of a pension computed as though on the date of his retirement he had been retired under the Pensions Ordinance and had received the amount of the gratuity granted to him from the Provident Fund less the difference repaid by him, as the

gratuity receivable upon an election under the Pensions Ordinance for a gratuity and a reduced pension, or

- (ii) if he does not pay to the Accountant General the amount referred to under subparagraph (i), for the payment of a pension computed as though on the date of his retirement he had been retired under the Pensions Ordinance and had received the amount of the gratuity granted to him from the Provident Fund less the difference not paid by him as the gratuity receivable upon the election under the Pensions Ordinance for a gratuity and reduced pension but the Accountant General shall deduct the amount owed from such pension in equal monthly instalments for any period not exceeding ten years in the discretion of the Accountant General.

(3) Subparagraph (ii) of paragraph (c) of subsection (2) shall not be construed to give any claim or charge upon the estate of a pensioner where a pensioner dies before the total unpaid balance is deducted by the Accountant General from the pension of the deceased pensioner.

7. After the commencement of this Ordinance, the Provident Fund Ordinance applies only in respect of—

- (a) daily-paid employees in the service of the Government of Trinidad and Tobago, and
- (b) those persons who elect, in accordance with section 4, to continue to be depositors to the Provident Fund.

8. The Governor in Council may by notice published in the *Royal Gazette* vary the Schedule by adding thereto any other office.
