AN ORDINANCE to amend the Promissory Oaths Ordinance, Cap. 78.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Short title.
Construction.
Cap. 78

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Promissory Oaths (Amendment) Ordinance, 1937, and shall be construed as one with the Promissory Oaths Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Sec. 6 of Cap.
78 replaced.

2. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following :—

By whom oath
of allegiance
and official
oath shall be
taken.

6. The oath of allegiance and the official oath shall be tendered to and taken by each of the superior executive officers as soon as may be after his acceptance of office.

3. Section 16 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following :— Sec. 16 of Cap. 8 replac ed.

16. No person who has on any occasion taken the oath of allegiance, which oath has been duly recorded, shall be required to repeat the same oath on appointment to any office or on any other occasion. Avoidance of repetition of oath of allegiance

4. Sections 9 and 12 of the Principal Ordinance are hereby repealed. Secs. 9 and 12 of Cap. 78 repealed.
