**AN ACT to amend the Caribbean Aviation Training
Institute Act, 1975.**

[Assented to 15th August, 1980]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as **Enactment**
follows: —

1. This Act may be cited as the Caribbean Aviation **short title**
Training Institute (Amendment) Act, 1980.

2. The Caribbean Aviation Training Institute Act, 1975 is amended by repealing subsection (1) of section 7 and replacing it as follows—

“Exemptions

7. (1) The Institute, its assets, operations and transactions shall, subject to subsection (2), be exempt from the payment of—

- (a) all direct taxation;
- (b) customs duties or charges of equivalent effect on any article imported for its official use; and
- (c) excise duties on aircraft fuel used for the purpose of training student pilots.”.
