AN ACT deeming Lester Jemmott as having attained the
age of compulsory retirement on his discharge
from the Defence Force as a Warrant Officer I.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago Enactment
as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Lester Jemmott Short title
(Superannuation Benefits) Act, 1984.

2. Lester Jemmott, retired Warrant Officer I of the Trinidad and Tobago Defence Force, is deemed to have attained the compulsory age of retirement on his discharge from the said Defence Force and is further deemed to be eligible to receive retirement benefits in accordance with regulation 7A of the Defence (Pensions, Terminal and Other Grants) Regulations.
