AN ORDINANCE to amend the Roads Ordinance,  
Cap. 124.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Roads Short title.  
Construction.  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1933, and shall be construed  
as one with the Roads Ordinance, Cap. 124, hereinafter  
called the Principal Ordinance, and shall come into Commence-  
ment.  
operation on the date of publication in the *Royal Gazette*.

2. Sub-section (1) of section 41 of the Principal Ordinance Amendment  
of s. 41 (1) of  
Cap. 124.  
is hereby amended by inserting the word "removal" after  
the word "appointment" in the seventh line of the said  
sub-section.

Pension rights  
of officers of  
superseded  
Board.

3. The following shall be inserted as sub-section (5) of section 44 of the Principal Ordinance :—

(5) Notwithstanding the supersession of a Local Board in accordance with the provisions of this section any rights that may have accrued to any officer of a Local Board so superseded in respect of a pension or gratuity under the provisions of section 42 of this Ordinance shall be preserved and continued in full force and effect, and during the continuance of such supersession the Director of Public Works may exercise all the powers of the Local Board so superseded in regard to pensions and gratuities of officers of such Board.
