REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 33 of 1981

AN ACT to amend the Caribbean Industrial Research Institute Act, 1971 and to validate certain acts done thereunder.

[Assented to 7th September, 1981]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as **Enactment** follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Caribbean Industrial Short title Research Institute (Amendment and Validation) Act, 1981.

2. The Caribbean Industrial Research Institute Act (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") is amended by deleting the definition of "the Council" occurring in section 2.

3. The Act is amended by renumbering section 3(1) as section 3 and by repealing subsection (2).

4. The Act is amended by repealing sections 10, 11 and 12 and by renumbering sections 13 to 17 as sections 10 to 14.

5. The Act is amended by deleting the words "and implement policy decisions of the Council" occurring in line two of section 11 as renumbered.

Acts deemed
to have been
lawfully and
validly done

6. All acts done by the Institute in purported exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Act are deemed to have been lawfully and validly done notwithstanding the fact that the Institute was not properly constituted at the time when those acts were done and no legal proceedings shall be instituted or entertained in respect or in consequence of such acts and things by reason only of that fact.

Commencement

7. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation contemporaneously with the Act.
