AN ACT to amend the Veterinary Surgeons (Registration)
Ordinance.

[Assented to 7th March, 1963]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by ^{Enactment}
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House
of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the
authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Veterinary Surgeons ^{Short title}
(Registration) (Amendment) Act, 1963.

2. The Veterinary Surgeons (Registration) Ordinance is amended—

(a) by deleting the definition of “Board” occurring in section 2 thereof and substituting therefor the following:—

“ “Board” means the Veterinary Surgeons Registration Board constituted under section 2A;”;

(b) by inserting immediately after section 2 thereof the following section—

“Constitution
of the Board

2A. There is hereby constituted for the purposes of this Ordinance a body, to be called the Veterinary Surgeons Registration Board, consisting of—

(a) the Technical Officer (Animal Health) who is *ex officio* chairman of the Board, and

(b) two persons eligible to be registered under paragraph (a) or paragraph (b) of section 6 to be appointed from time to time by the Governor-General.”
