AN ORDINANCE to amend the Widows' and Orphans'  
Pensions Ordinance, Ch. 9. No. 8

[1st April, 1954.]

Commencement

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago, with the Enactment  
advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Widows' and Orphans' Short title  
Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, and shall be read as Ch. 9. No. 8  
one with the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance, here-  
inafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

**2.** The time within which it shall be competent for teachers by notice in writing to elect under the terms of paragraph (c) of subsection (3) of section 3 of the Principal Ordinance, as amended by section 3 of the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952-1953, that the provisions of the Principal Ordinance shall not apply to them is hereby extended so as to include any such notice received by the Director of Education not later than three months from the date of the coming into operation of this Ordinance.

Refund of  
contributions  
in certain cases

**3.** There shall be refunded to every teacher who under and by virtue of the provisions of this Ordinance, elects that the provisions of the Principal Ordinance shall not apply to him, all contributions made by him under the Principal Ordinance or any amendment thereto, up to the date of such election.
