Act No. 9 of 1964

AN ACT to amend the Cocoa Industry Ordinance, 1961.

[Assented to on 29th April, 1964.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Cocoa Industry (Amendment) Act, 1964. Short title

2. Section 17 of the Cocoa Industry Ordinance is amended—

- (a) by inserting immediately after the words "the Minister" appearing in subsection (2) thereof, the words "; and unless the Minister otherwise directs, no dividend shall be paid to any producer who fails to submit his claim therefor on or before the date so fixed.";
- (b) by inserting immediately after subsection (2) thereof the following subsection :

"(2a) Notwithstanding subsections (1) and (2), if any claims for the payment of the dividend declared in respect of each of the two crop years ending 30th September, 1963 are submitted after the date fixed for the submission of the same, the Minister may direct the Board to pay in respect of those claims such portion only of the dividend as he may think fit, if the Board represents to him that such dividend would have been declared if those claims had been submitted on or before the date fixed in that behalf."
