AN ACT to amend the Central Bank Act, 1964.

[Assented to 1st August, 1969]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment:
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Central Bank (Amend- Short title
ment) Act, 1969.

2. The Central Bank Act, 1964, is hereby amended—
(a) by adding after paragraph (f) of subsection (2) of section 33, the following new paragraph:

“(g) special drawing rights (and any foreign exchange proceeds resulting from their use) constituting assets of the account authorised by subsection (6) of section 4 of the International Financial Organisations Act, 1963.”;

- (b) in section 36, by relettering paragraph (s) as paragraph (t) and by inserting immediately after paragraph (r) the following paragraph—

“(s) acquire, hold and transfer or otherwise dispose of special drawing rights (and any foreign exchange proceeds resulting from their use) constituting assets of the account authorised by subsection (6) of section 4 of the International Financial Organisations Act, 1963.”.
